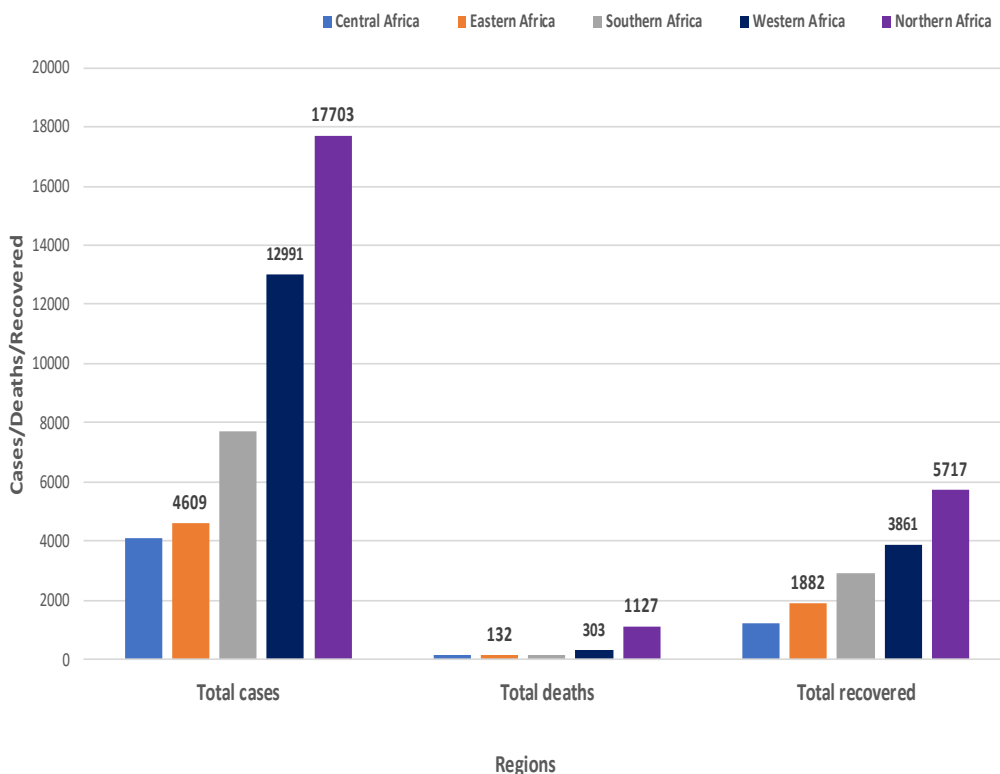

Algeria, Egypt & Morocco (93.3%)

Eastern: 9.8% (Djibouti, Kenya, Somalia & Sudan (66%))

Southern: Low cases; South Africa (93.8%)

West: High cases in Senegal, Guinea & Mali  
High testing in Ghana (129,461)

Average CFR 2.3% However in Northern (6.5%)

The average recovery rate of 30.1% for the Central, Northern and Western Africa 37.8% for the Southern Africa where Zambia reported a highest recovery rate of 66.0% and Eswatini the least with 10.3%. Eastern Africa reported the highest recovery rate of 40.7%. Mauritius report the highest rate of 95.5%, and Somalia together with Sudan reported the least of 9.0%. In here, Ethiopia has posted a 62.8% recovery rate.
