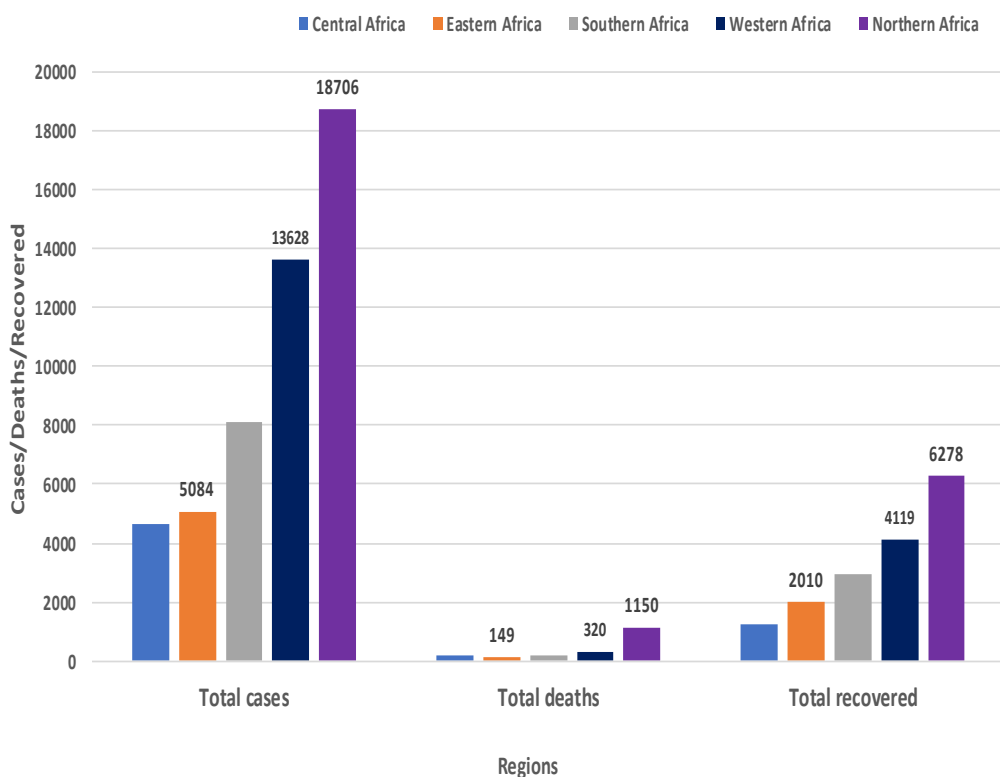

Comparison of the prevalence of COVID-19 in African Regions; 6-May-2020



North: 37.3% cases
Algeria, Egypt & Morocco (93.5%) cases and 96.0% deaths

Eastern: 10.1% (Djibouti, Kenya, Somalia & Sudan (68.1%) cases and 78.5% deaths

Southern: 16.2%; South Africa (93.3%)

Western: 27.3% Nigeria, Ghana, Guinea, Cote d'Ivoire & Senegal reported 75.2% cases and 48.6% deaths

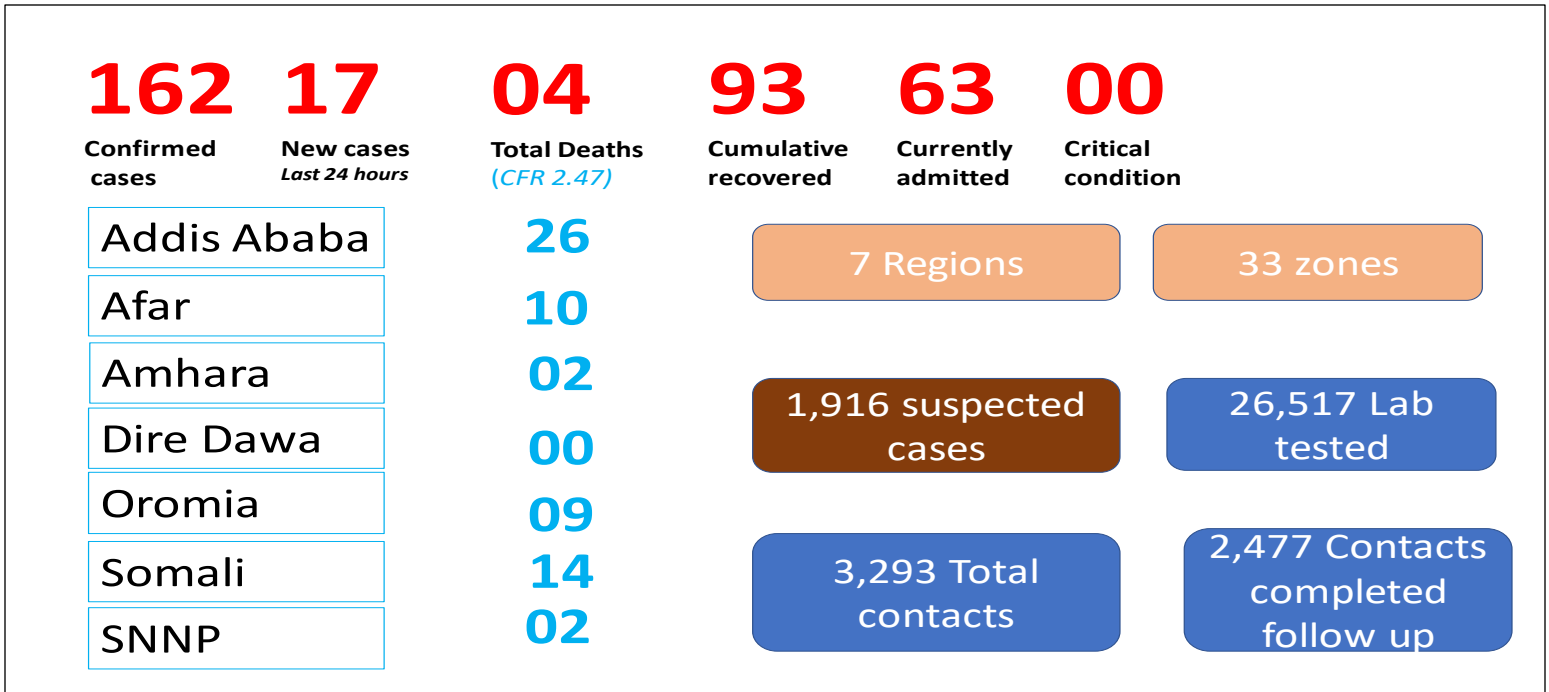
Central: 9.2% (Cameroon and DRC account for 66.6% cases and 78.1% deaths)

There is an average recovery rate of 26.4% in the Central, 32.1% in Northern and Western Africa. The recovery rate for Southern Africa stands at 36.0% of which Zambia reported a highest recovery rate of 69.2% and Eswatini the least with 10.1%. Eastern Africa reported the highest recovery rate of 39.5%. Mauritius report the highest rate of 95.7%, and Somalia together with Sudan reported the least of 9.1%. In here, Ethiopia has posted a 57.4% recovery rate.
