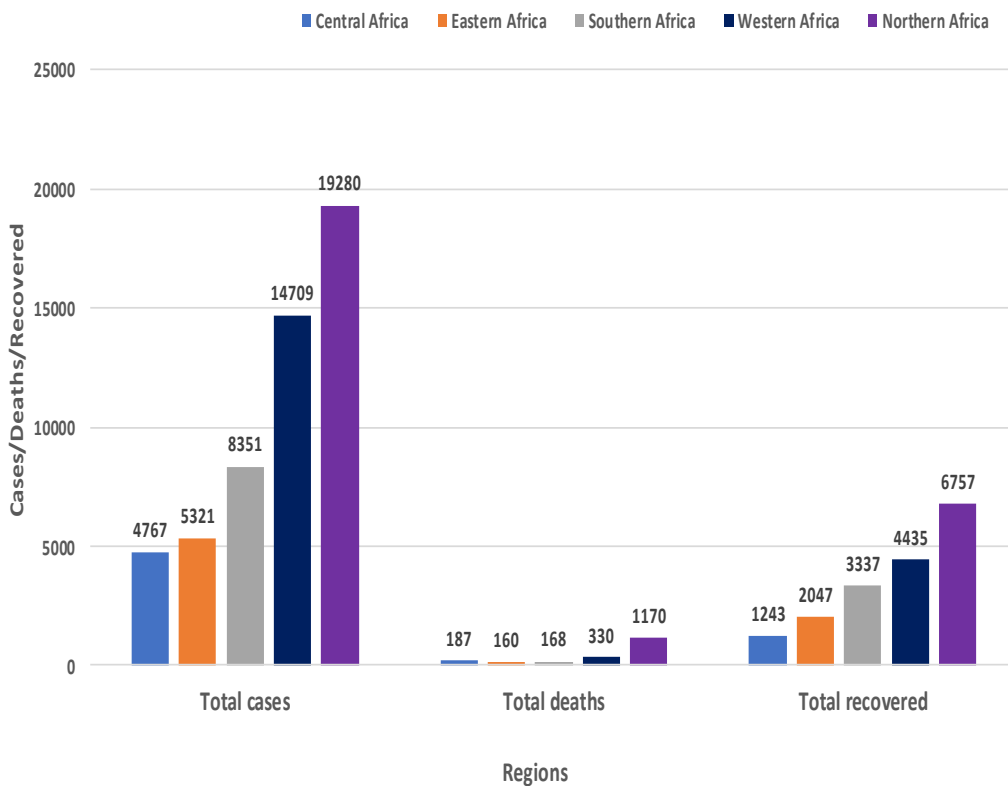

Comparison of the prevalence of COVID-19 in Africa Regions; 7-May-2020



North: 36.8% cases  
Algeria, Egypt & Morocco (92.7%) cases and 96.8% deaths

Eastern: 10.1% (Djibouti, Kenya, Somalia & Sudan (71.2%) cases and 79.1% deaths

Southern: 15.9%; South Africa (93.5%)

Western: 28.1% Nigeria, Ghana, Guinea, Cote d'Ivoire & Senegal reported 77.6% cases and 49.3% deaths

Central: 9.1% (Cameroon and DRC account for 66.9% cases and 78.8% deaths)

There is an average recovery rate of 26.1% in the Central, 35.0% in Northern and 30.2 in the Western Africa. The recovery rate for Southern Africa stands at 40.0% of which Zambia reported a highest recovery rate of 70.1% and Eswatini the least with 10.0%. Eastern Africa reported the highest recovery rate of 41.3% of which Mauritius posted the highest rate of 96.5%, and Somalia together with Sudan reported the least of 901%. In here, Ethiopia has posted a 49.7% recovery rate.
