Fig 1: Number of confirmed coronavirus cases reported globally in the last 7 days (22-28 Jul)

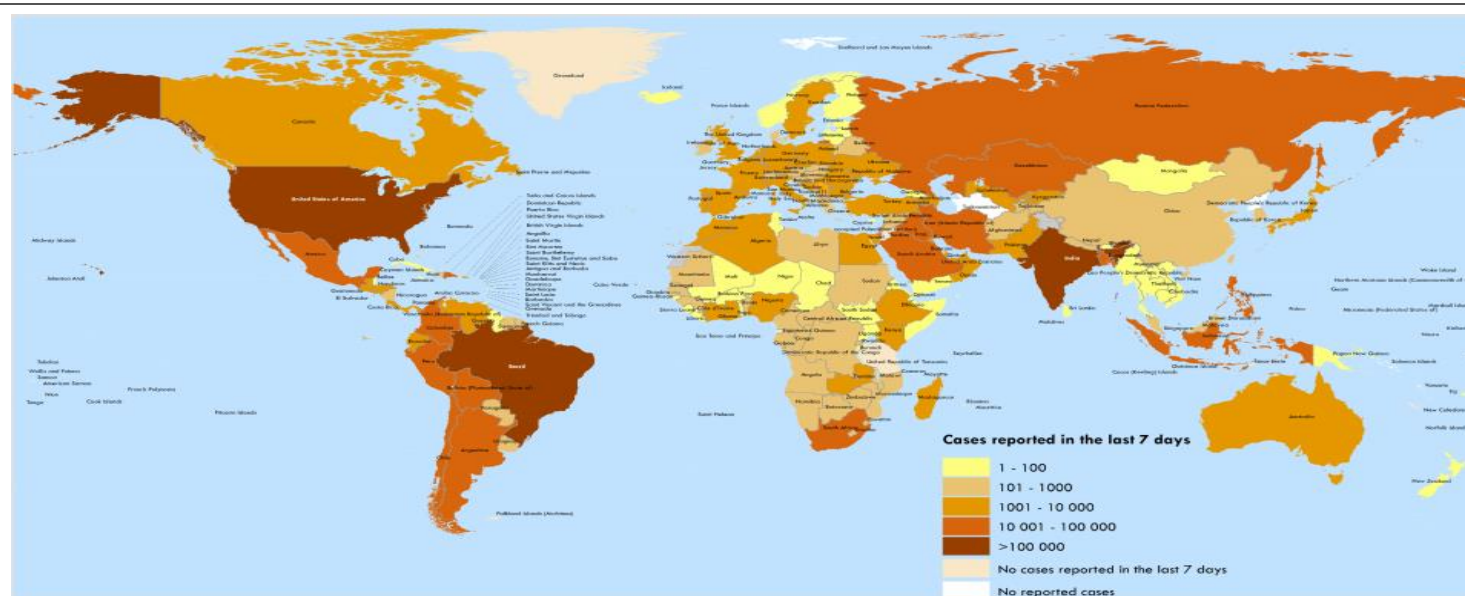


Fig 2: The summary of coronavirus within the five African regions; 28 July 2020

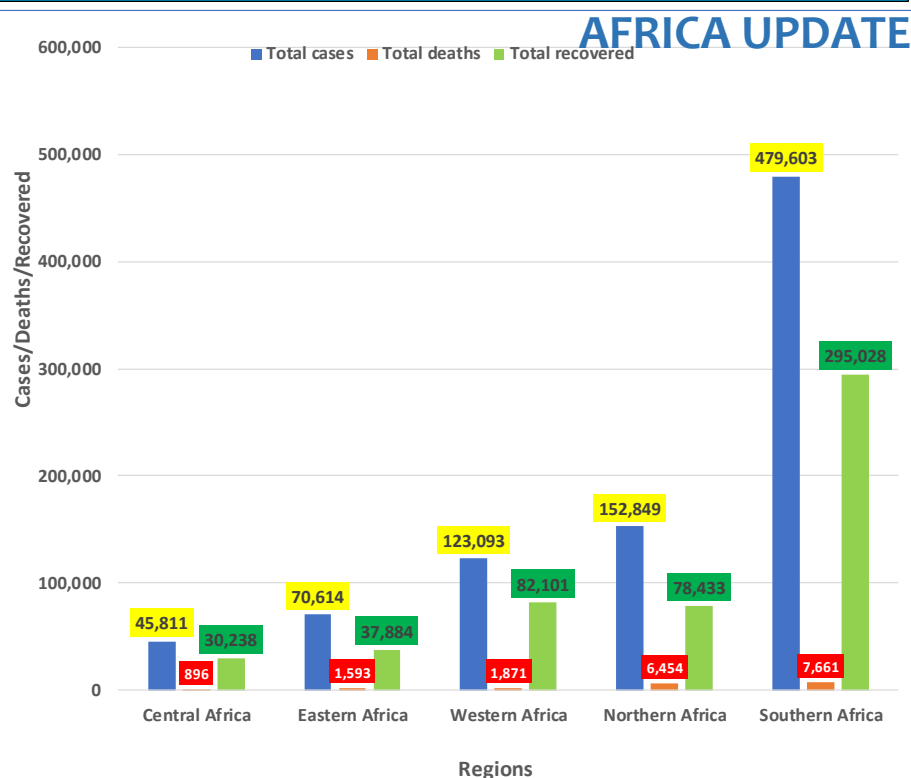

▪ **Eighty-six** health worker infections were retrospectively reported from Madagascar (68) and Guinea-Bissau (18).

▪ A total **14 177** (2.0%) health workers from **40** countries has been infected, with South Africa having **34%** (4 821/14 177) of all the reported cases. Gambia 20% (64/326) and Niger 16% (184/1 132) have the highest country specific proportion of health worker infections among confirmed cases.

Fig 3: New confirmed coronavirus cases in Ethiopia within the last 3 days; 28 July 2020

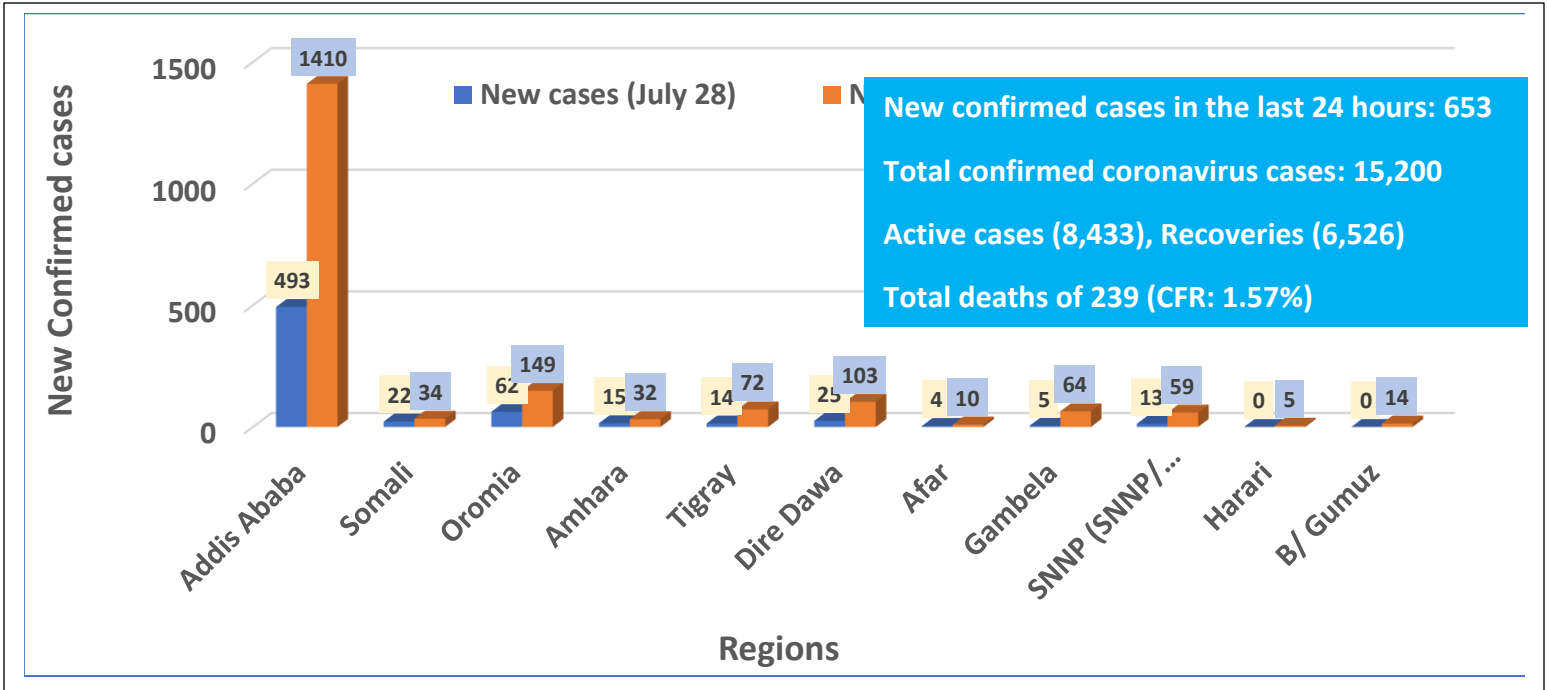


Fig 4: Total confirmed coronavirus cases in various regions of Ethiopia; 28 July 2020
