Fig 1: Number of confirmed coronavirus cases reported globally in the last 7 days (23-29 Jul)

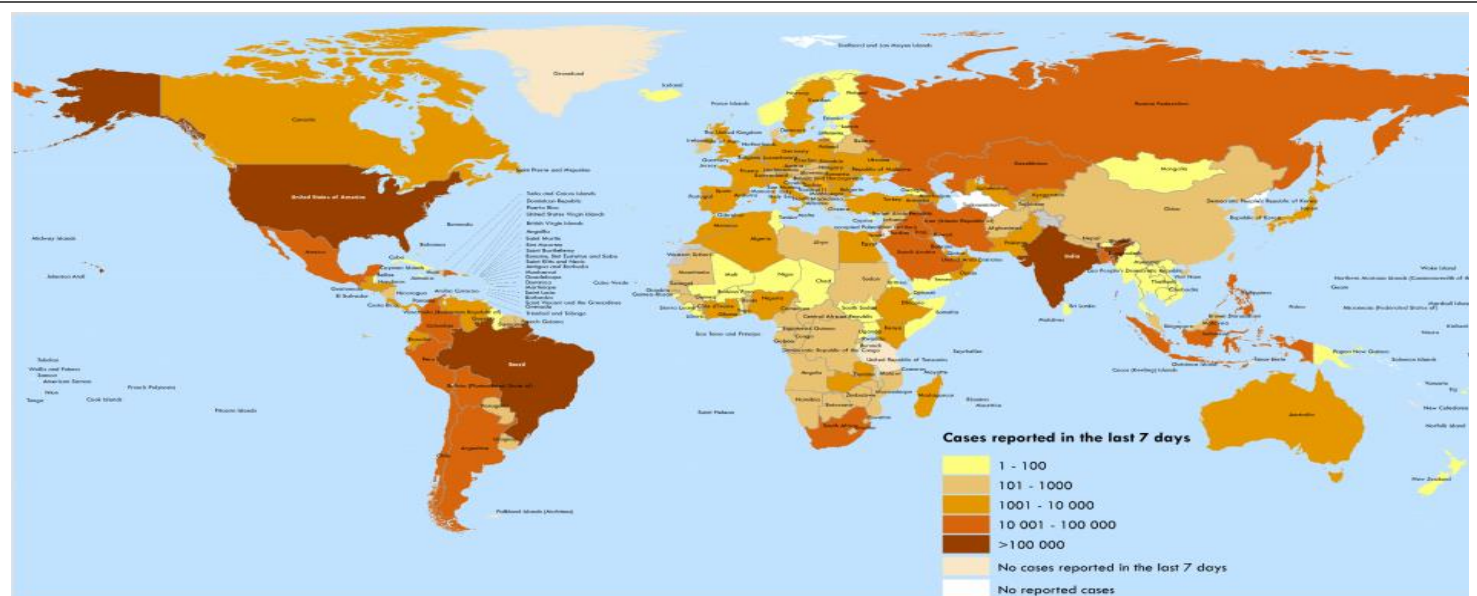


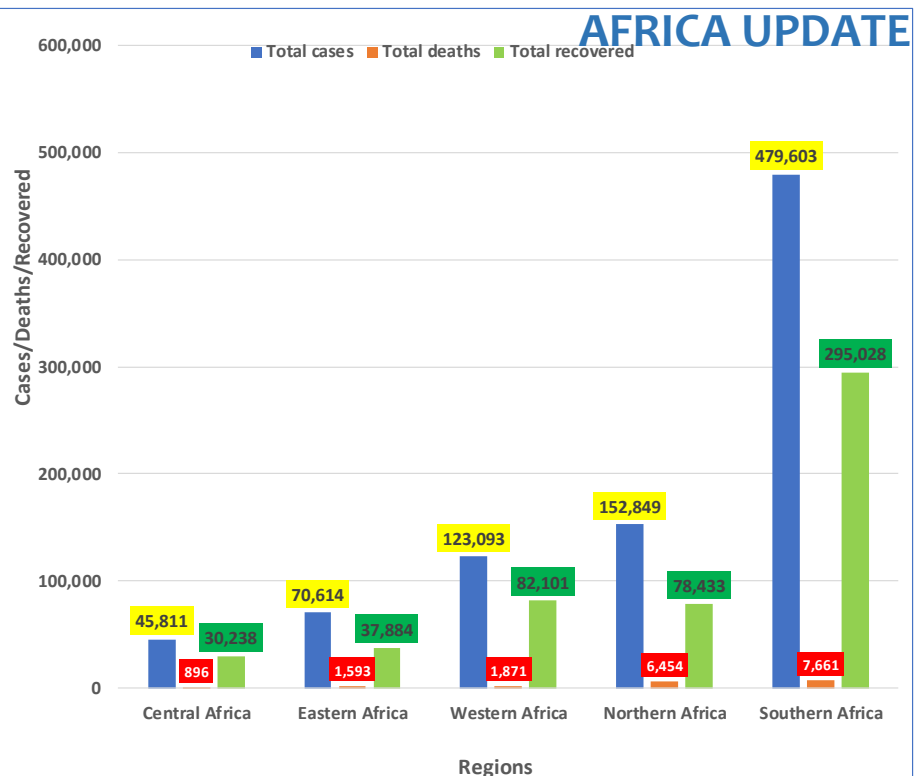
Fig 2: The summary of coronavirus within the five African regions; 29 July 2020

- Eighty-six health worker infections were retrospectively reported from Madagascar (68) and Guinea-Bissau (18).
A total 14 177 (2.0%) health workers from 40 countries has been infected, with South Africa having 34% (4 821/14 177) of all the reported cases. Gambia 20% (64/326) and Niger 16% (184/1 132) have the highest country specific proportion of health worker infections among confirmed cases.

Fig 3: The summary of coronavirus cases in Ethiopia as of; 29 July 2020

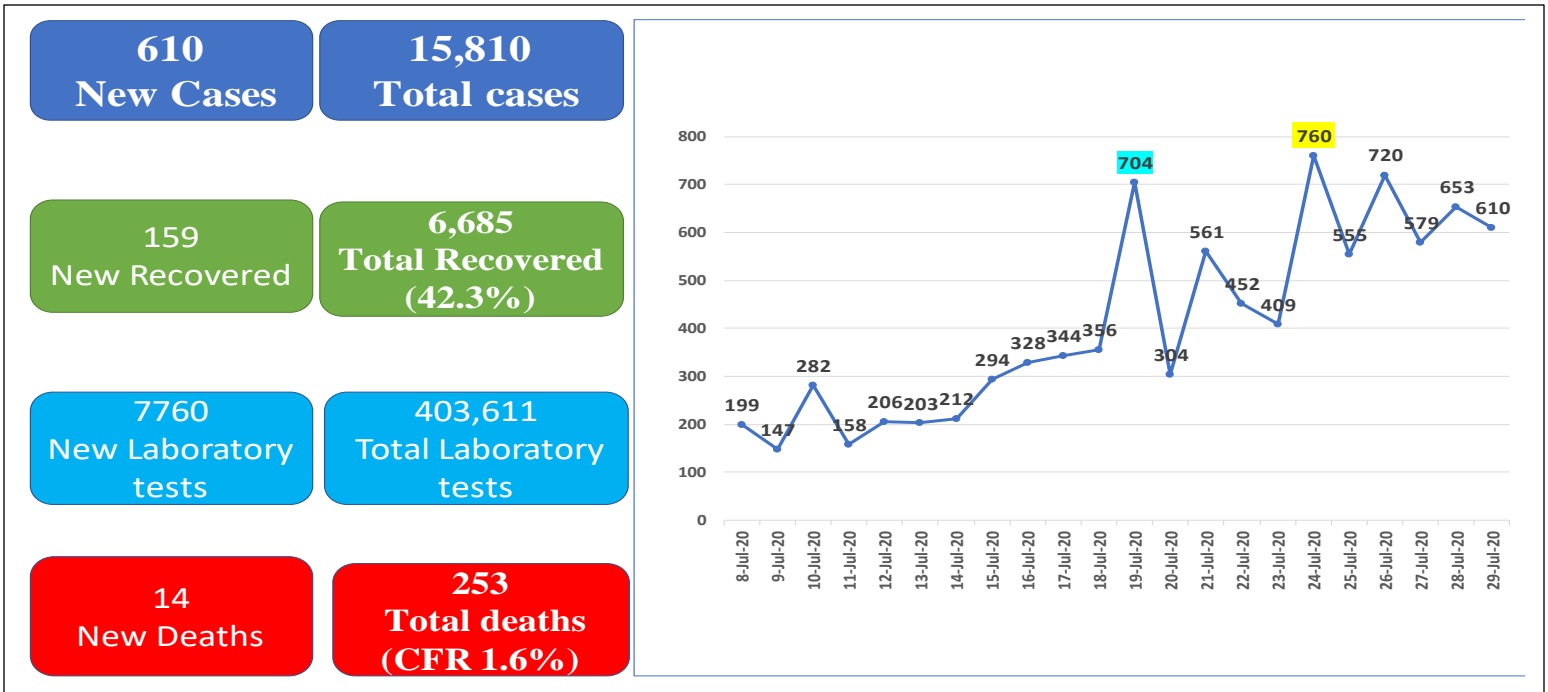


Fig 4: Total confirmed coronavirus cases in various regions of Ethiopia; 29 July 2020
