Fig 1: Number of confirmed coronavirus cases reported globally in the last 7 days (14-20 Jul)

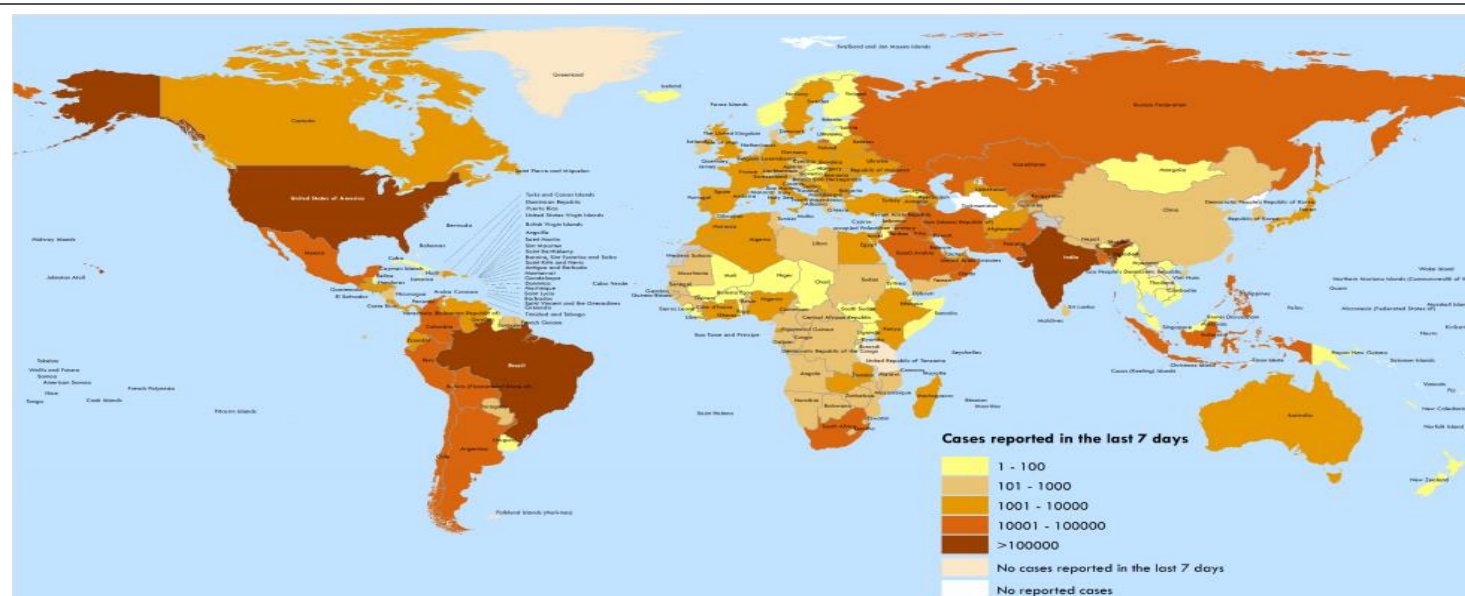


Fig 2: The summary of coronavirus within the five African regions; 20 July 2020

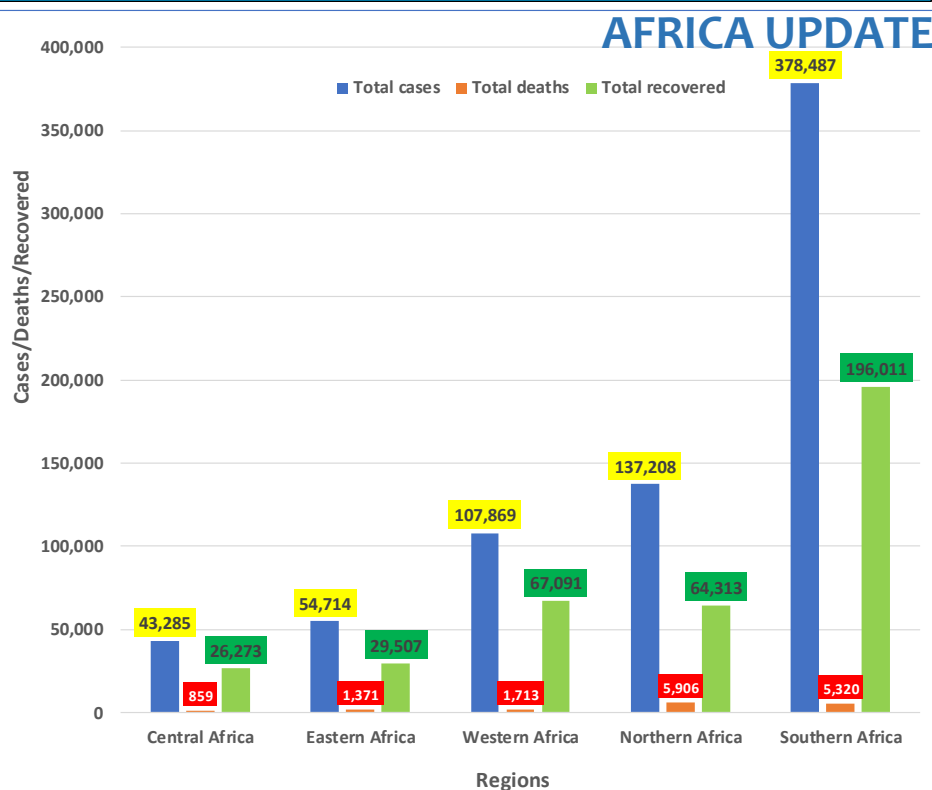

Fig 3: New confirmed coronavirus cases in Ethiopia within the last 3 days; 20 July 2020

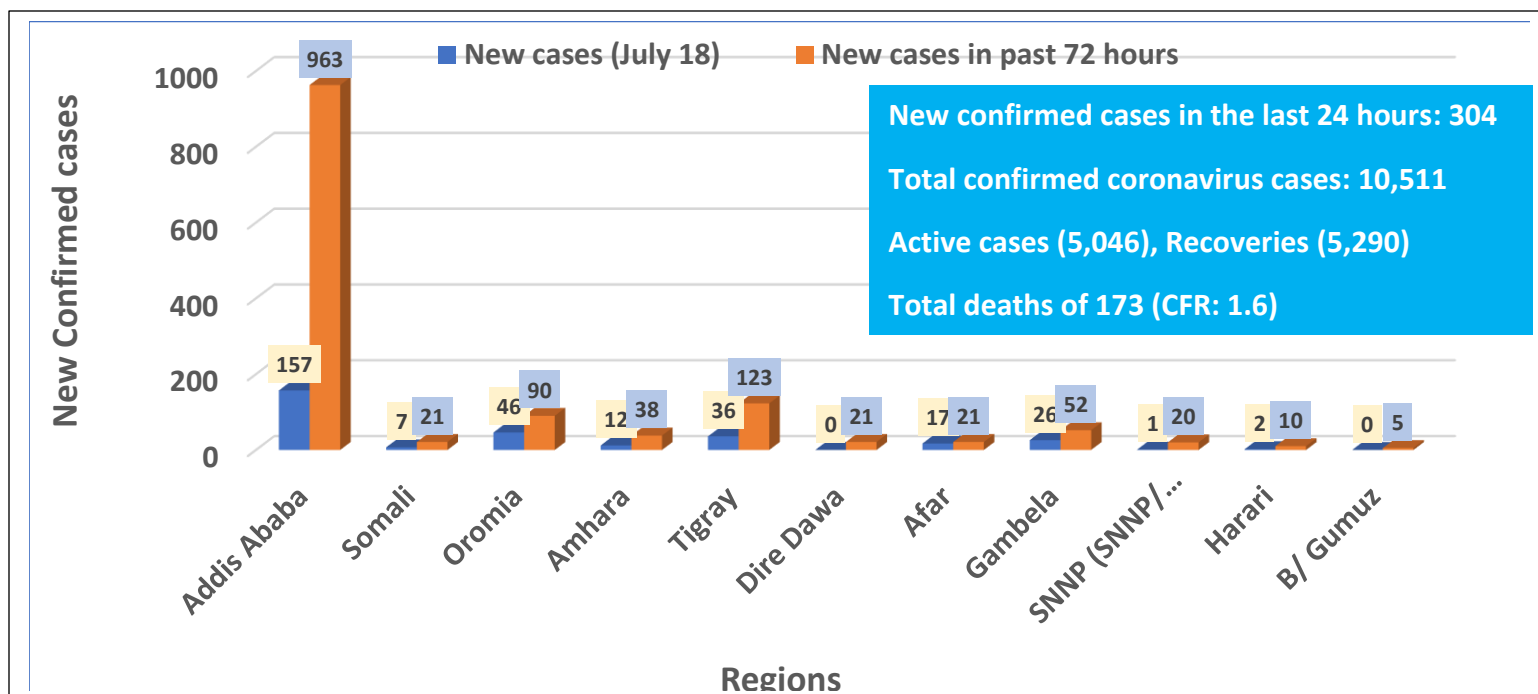


Fig 4: Total confirmed coronavirus cases in various regions of Ethiopia; 20 July 2020
