

### Fig 1: Number of confirmed coronavirus cases reported globally in the last 7 days (24-30 Jul)




## Fig 2: The summary of coronavirus within the five African regions; 30 July 2020

- A total of 300 new COVID-19 related deaths occurred in 14 countries: South Africa (240), Ethiopia (14), Algeria (12), Kenya (12), Madagascar (6), Nigeria (5), Zambia (4), Angola (1), Cabo Verde (1), Eswatini (1), Lesotho (1), Sao Tome and Principe (1), Sierra Leone (1) and Zimbabwe (1), in the past 24 hours.
- A total 14 214 (1.9%) health workers from 40 countries has been infected, with South Africa having 34% (4 821/14 214) of all the reported cases. Gambia 20% (64/326) and Niger 16% (184/1 134) have the highest country specific proportion of health worker infections among confirmed cases
