Fig 1: Number of confirmed coronavirus cases reported globally in the last 7 days (25-31 Jul)

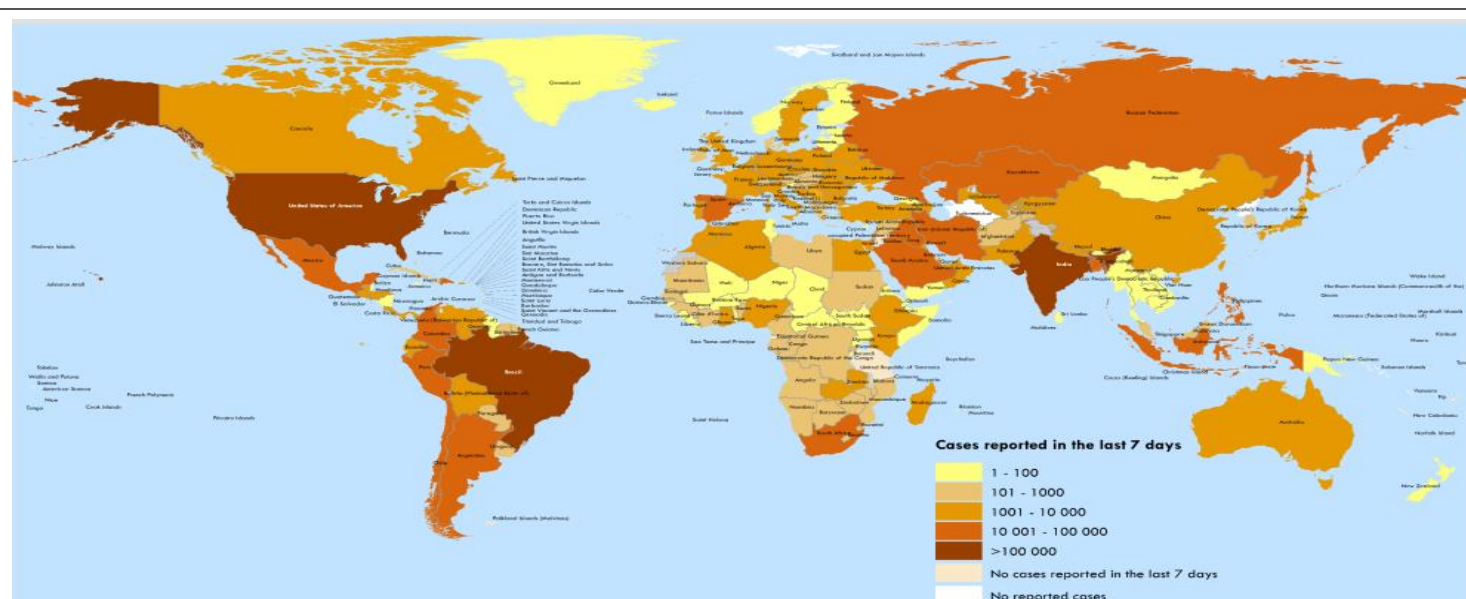
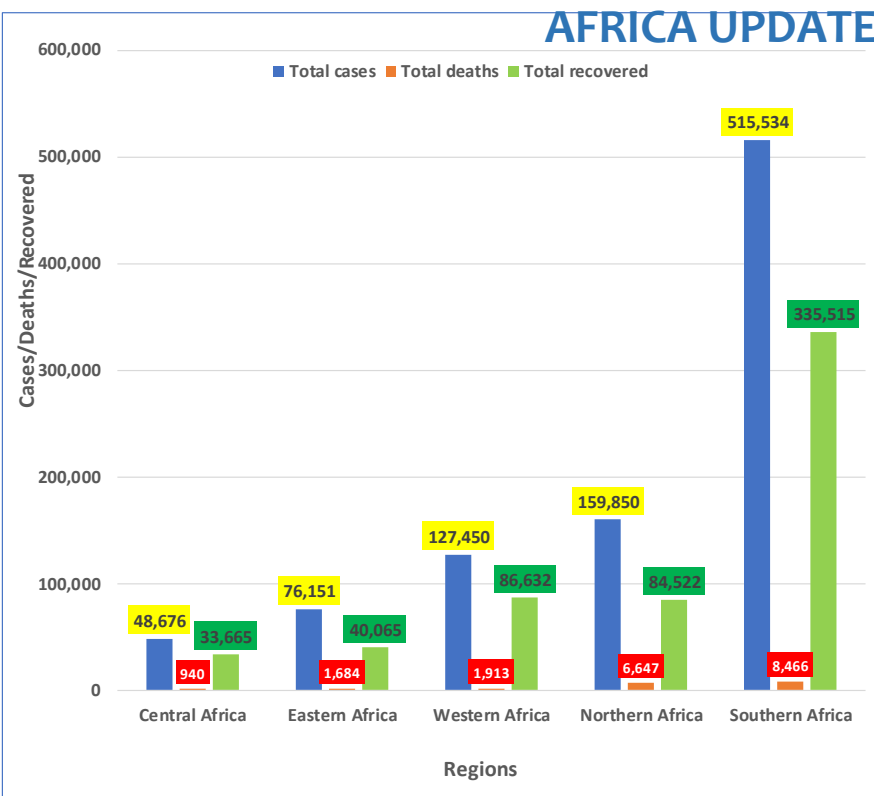


Fig 2: The summary of coronavirus within the five African regions; 31 July 2020

- Cases and corresponding deaths continue to increase in the African continent.
- South Africa has reported the highest number of cases constituting approximately 53% of the total cases and 41% of the total deaths in the continent
- In Eastern Africa, Kenya is the first country to post over 20,000 confirmed cases. However, Ethiopia is closely following Kenya and the cases are likely to reach 20,000 in a couple of days
- Cases in Madagascar have in the last couple of weeks more than tripled and currently totaling more than 10,000.

Fig 3: The summary of coronavirus cases in Ethiopia as of; 31 July 2020

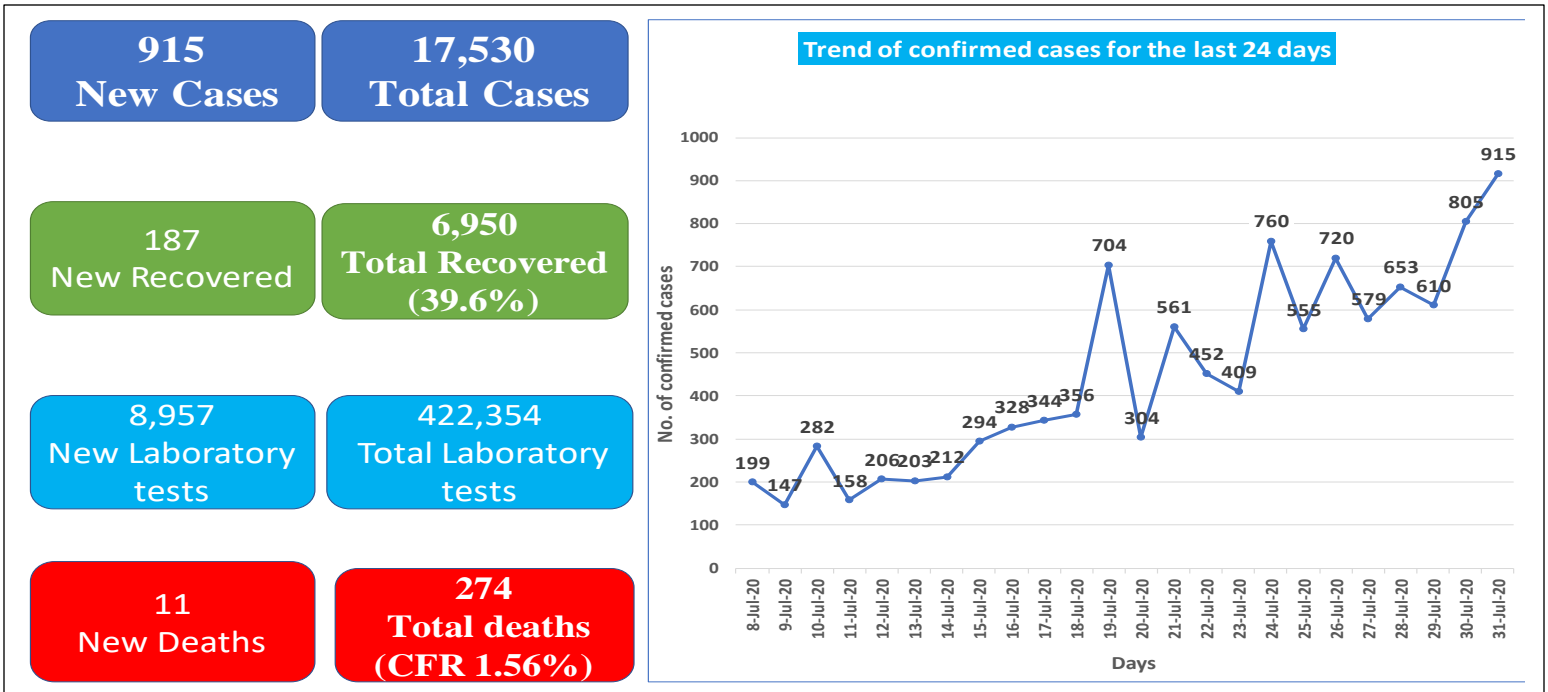


Fig 4: Total confirmed coronavirus cases in various regions of Ethiopia; 31 July 2020
