Fig 1: Number of confirmed coronavirus cases reported globally in the last 7 days; 02 Aug 2020

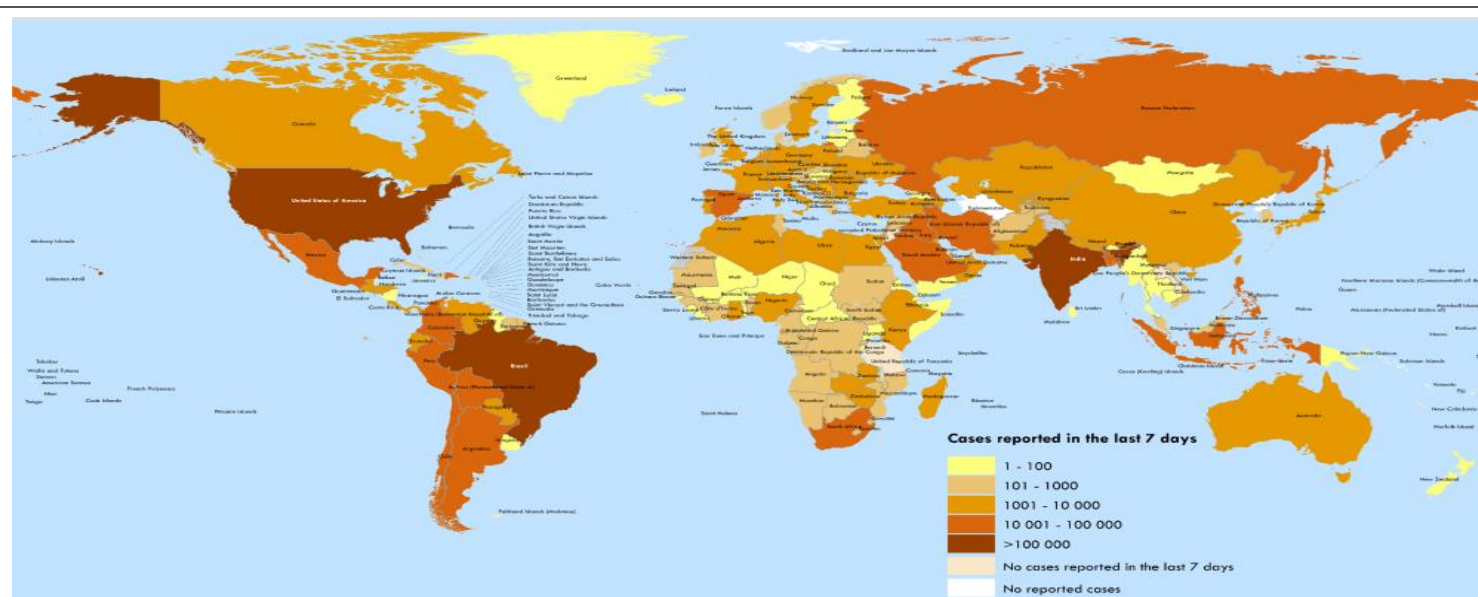


Fig 2: The summary of coronavirus within the five African regions; 02 August 2020

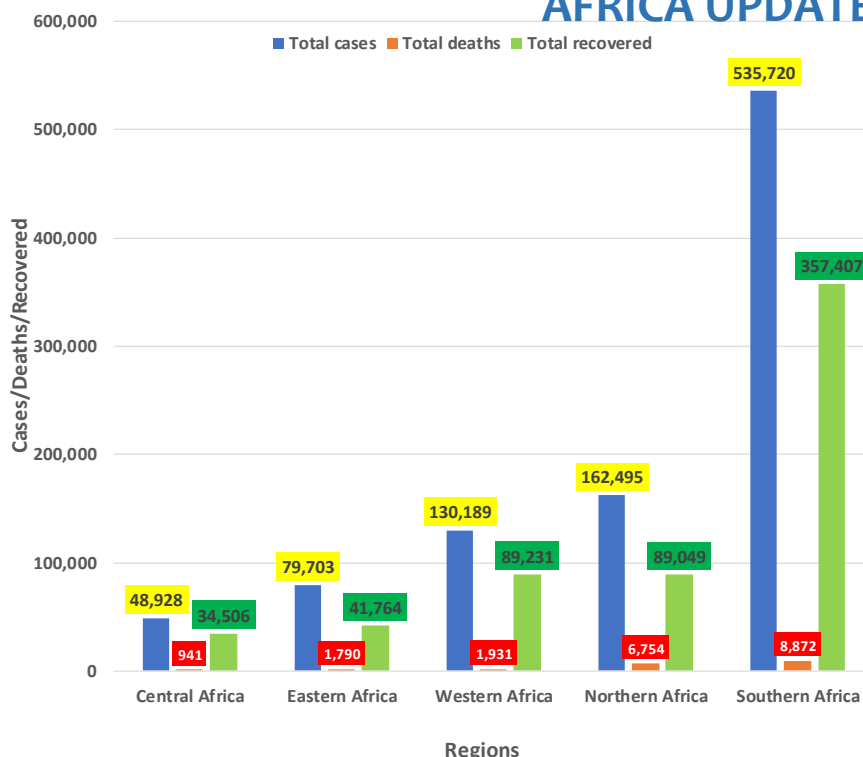

- As the cases in African continent approach a million, the total deaths has exceeded 20,000.
- South Africa continues to register high number of cases (503,290) and a corresponding deaths (8,153) with a Case fatality rate of 1.6
- Egypt has reported the second highest number of confirmed cases (94,316) on the continent and a corresponding deaths of 4,834 deaths with a case fatality rate of 5.1
- A further look at South Africa and Egypt indicates that South Africa has 866 cases/100,000 population and Egypt has 93 cases / 100,000 population.

Fig 3: The summary of coronavirus cases in Ethiopia as of; 02 August 2020

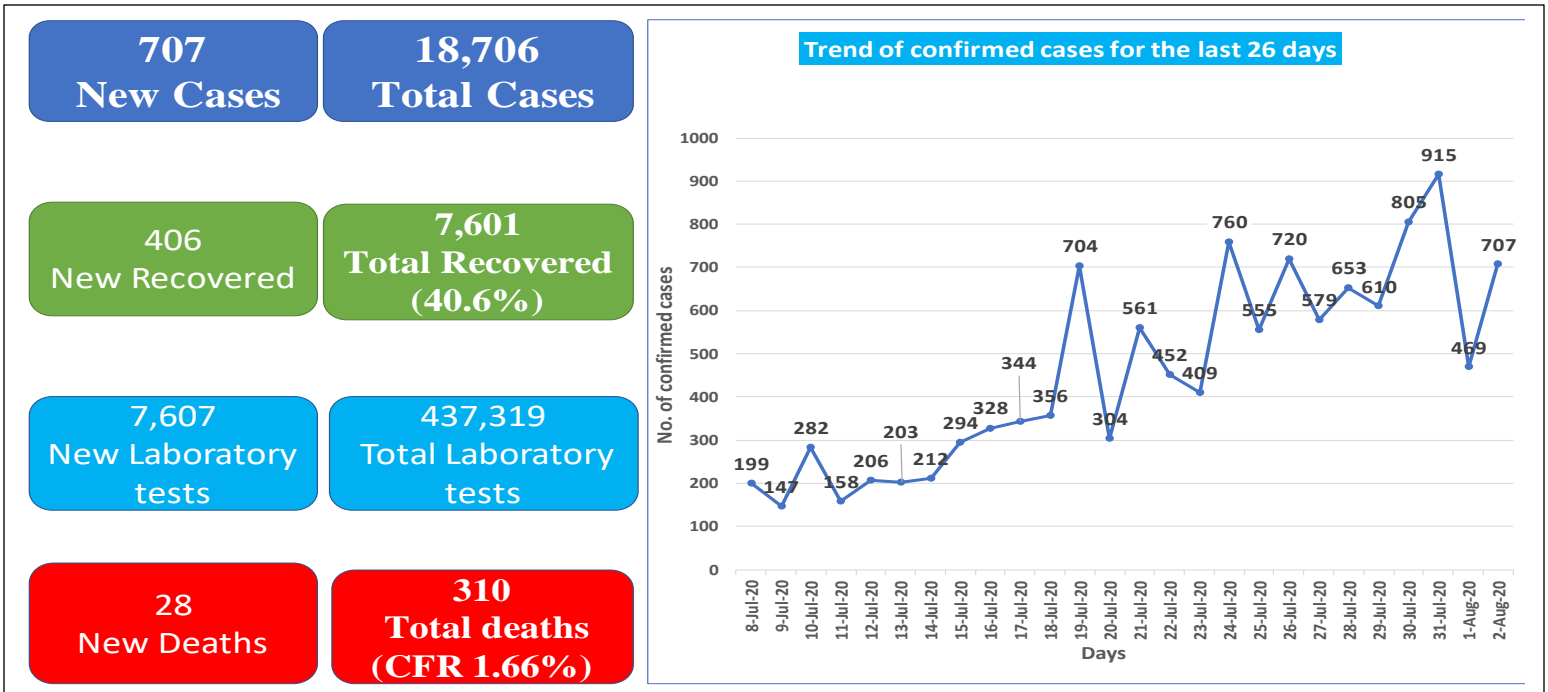


Fig 4: Total confirmed coronavirus cases in various regions of Ethiopia; 02 August 2020
