Fig 1: Number of confirmed coronavirus cases reported globally in the last 7 days; 10 Aug 2020

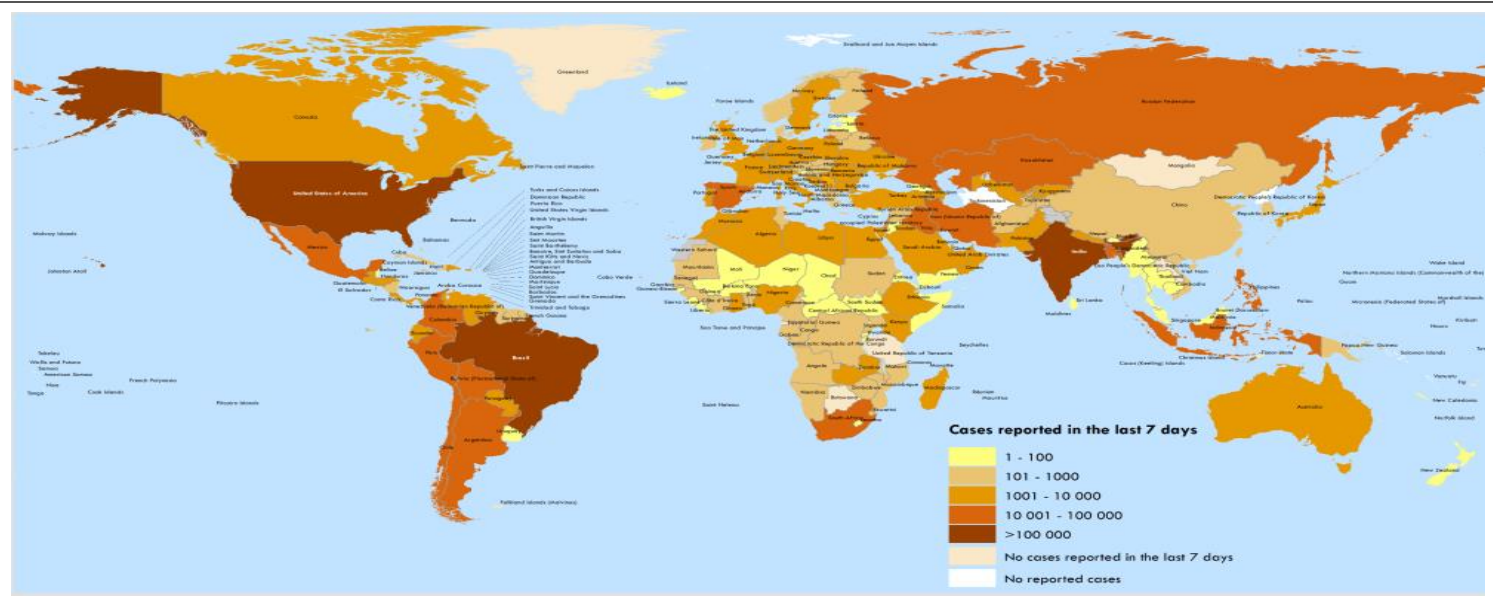
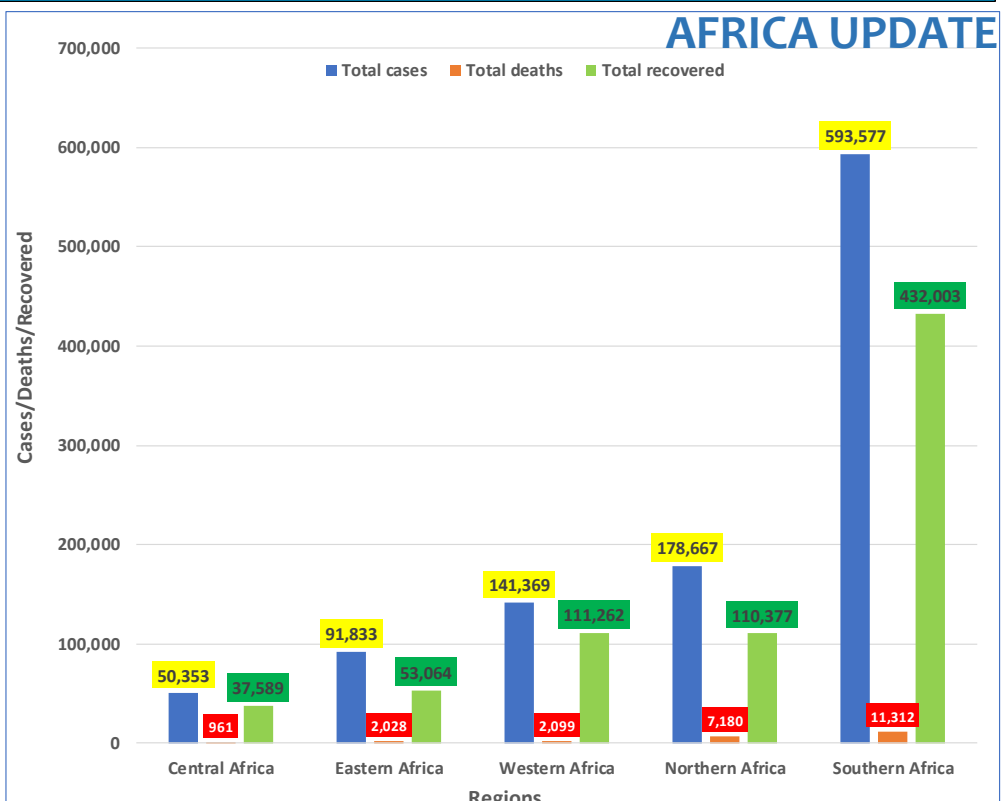


Fig 2: The summary of coronavirus within the five African regions; 10 August 2020

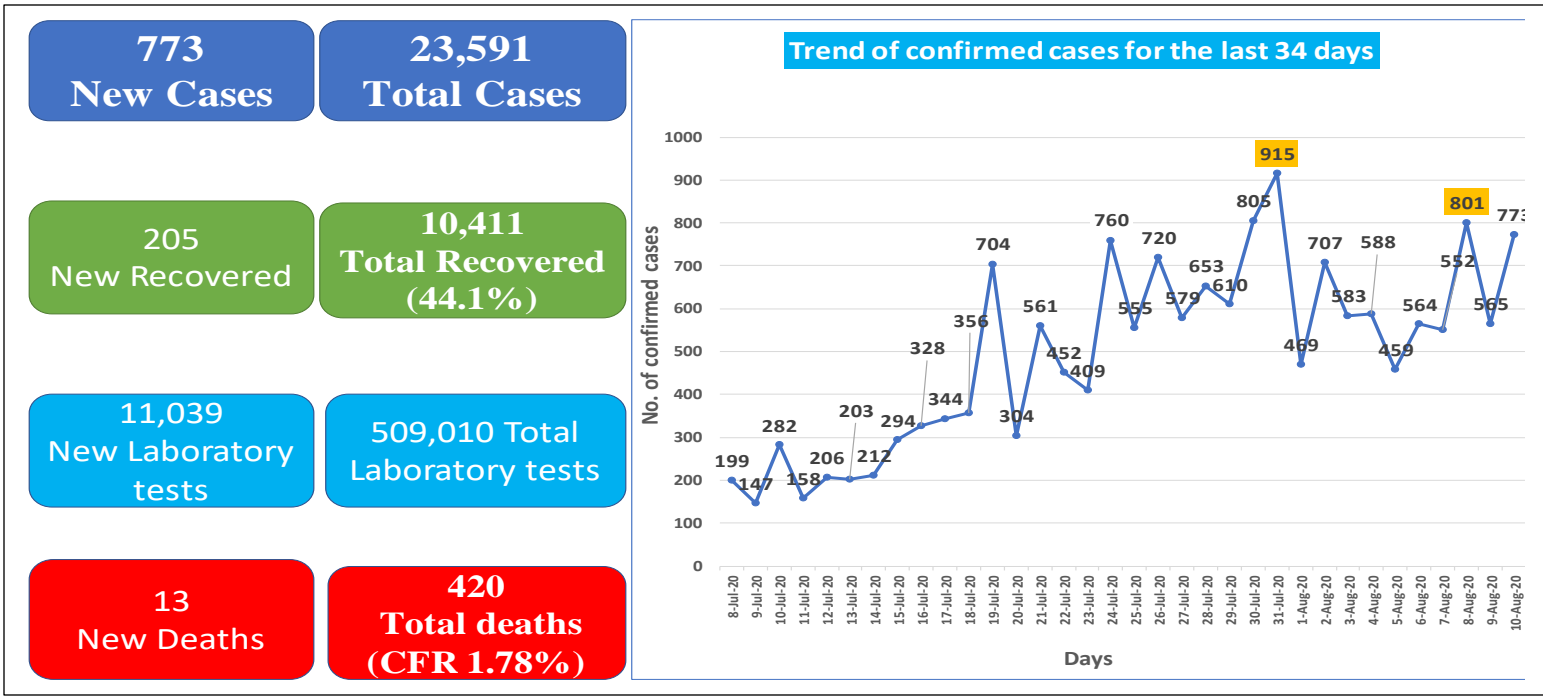

- Out of the 14 countries comprising Eastern Africa, Ethiopia and Kenya account for approximately 54.2% of the total confirmed cases and 41% of the deaths.
- Sudan which accounts for approximately 13% of the Eastern Africa cases, has the highest Case fatality rate of 6.5 as compared to Eritrea and Seychelles with a zero case fatality rate
- In the African continent, South Africa contributes approximately 53.4% of the total confirmed cases with a resultant 970 cases/100,000 population and 45% of the total deaths with case fatality rate of 1.9
