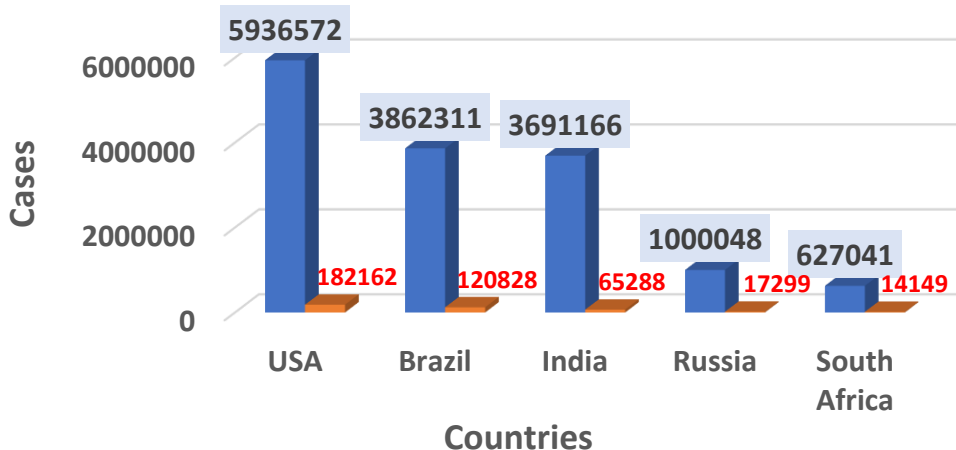

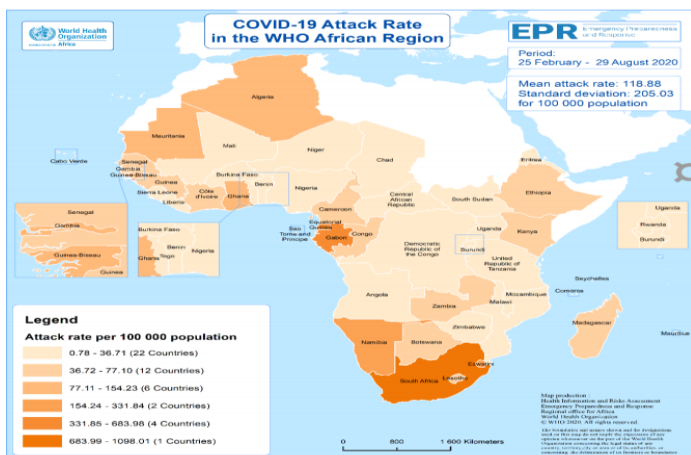

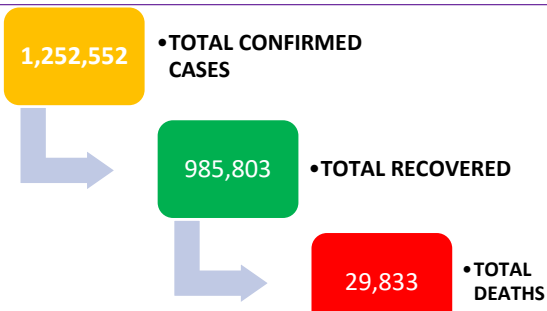
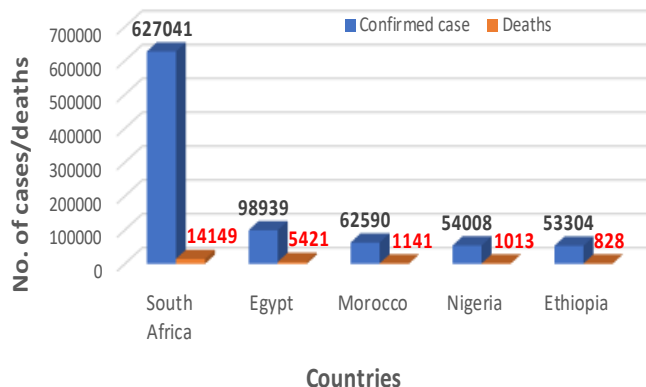

Five countries with the highest number of confirmed COVID-19 cases on the African continent; 01-Sep-2020



- In Africa, the top 5 countries reported 895,882 confirmed cases and 22,552 deaths representing 73.4% of the total reported confirmed cases and 78.2% deaths respectively.
- Mauritius reported a new COVID-19 case after 15 days with zero cases
- Seychelles has reported zero cases for the past 15 days

Fig. 3: Epidemiological details of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Ethiopia, 01-Sep 2020

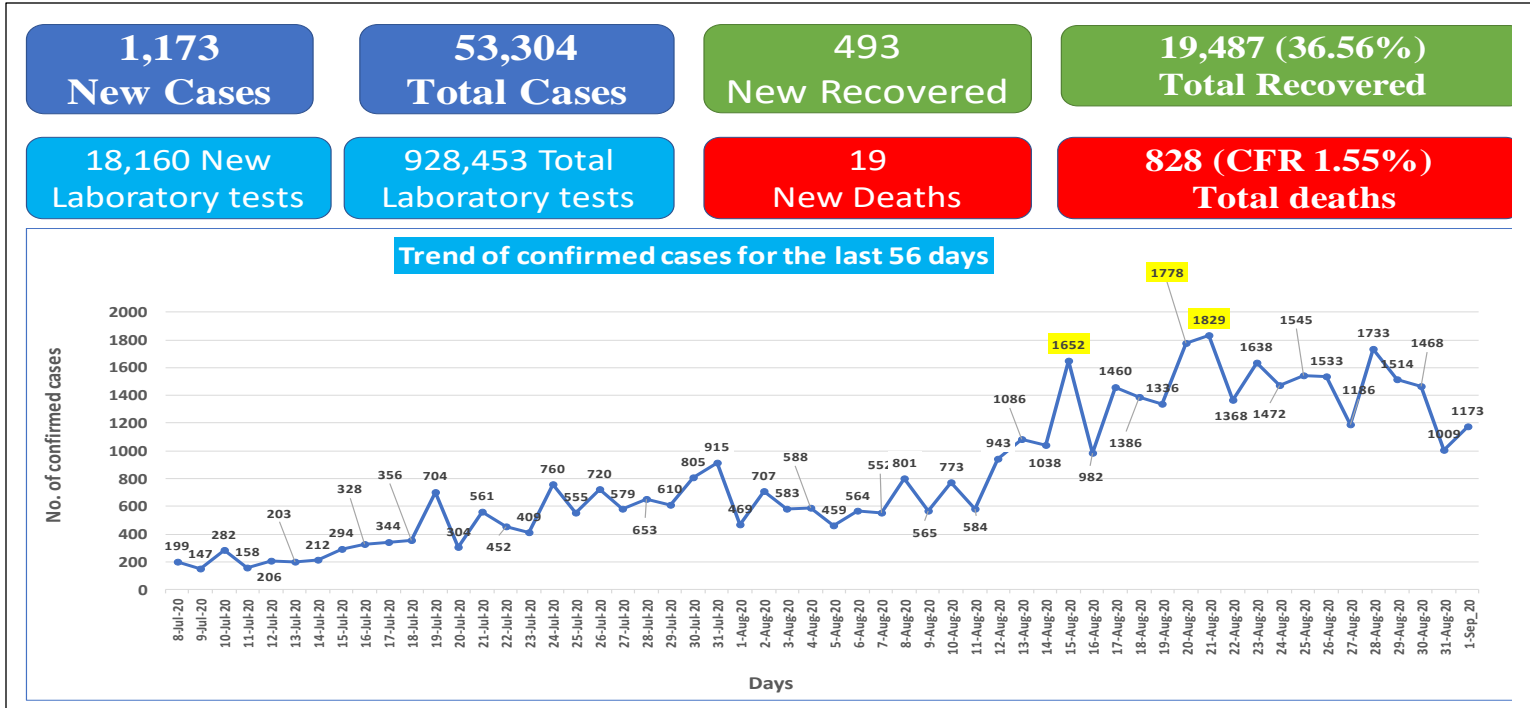


Fig. 4: Percentage distribution of confirmed COVID-19 cases with respect to age and sex in Ethiopia, 01-Sep 2020
