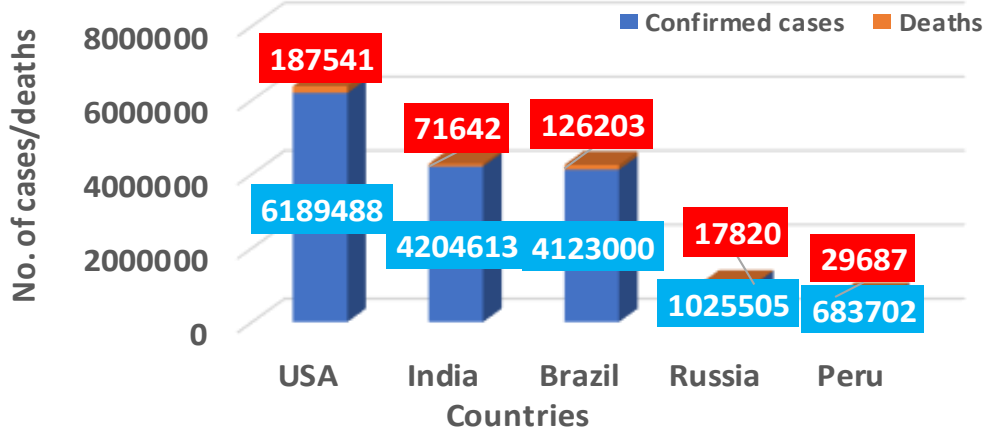

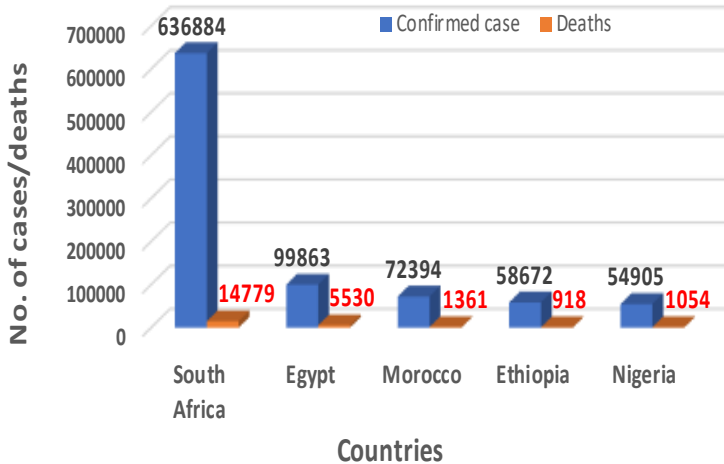

AFRICA

- Globally, the cases have increased close to **27 million** with a very sharp increase in case in South America especially Brazil, Peru, Columbia, Chile and Argentina. There is a marked reduction in the number of cases in South Africa and this has led to improving its previous 5th position ranking to 7th on the globe.
- In Africa, the top 5 countries reported **922,718** confirmed cases and **23,642** deaths representing **70.9%** of the total reported confirmed cases and **75.5%** deaths respectively.
- The total recovered in the continent have just exceeded a million mark.
- Ethiopia currently occupies the **4th** position in the number of confirmed cases in African continent and the **2nd** position in the WHO Africa region just after South Africa.
- Nevertheless, there is a landmark achievement of over **ONE MILLION rT_PCR LABORATORY TESTS** so far conducted in the country

Fig. 3: Epidemiological details of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Ethiopia, 06-Sep 2020

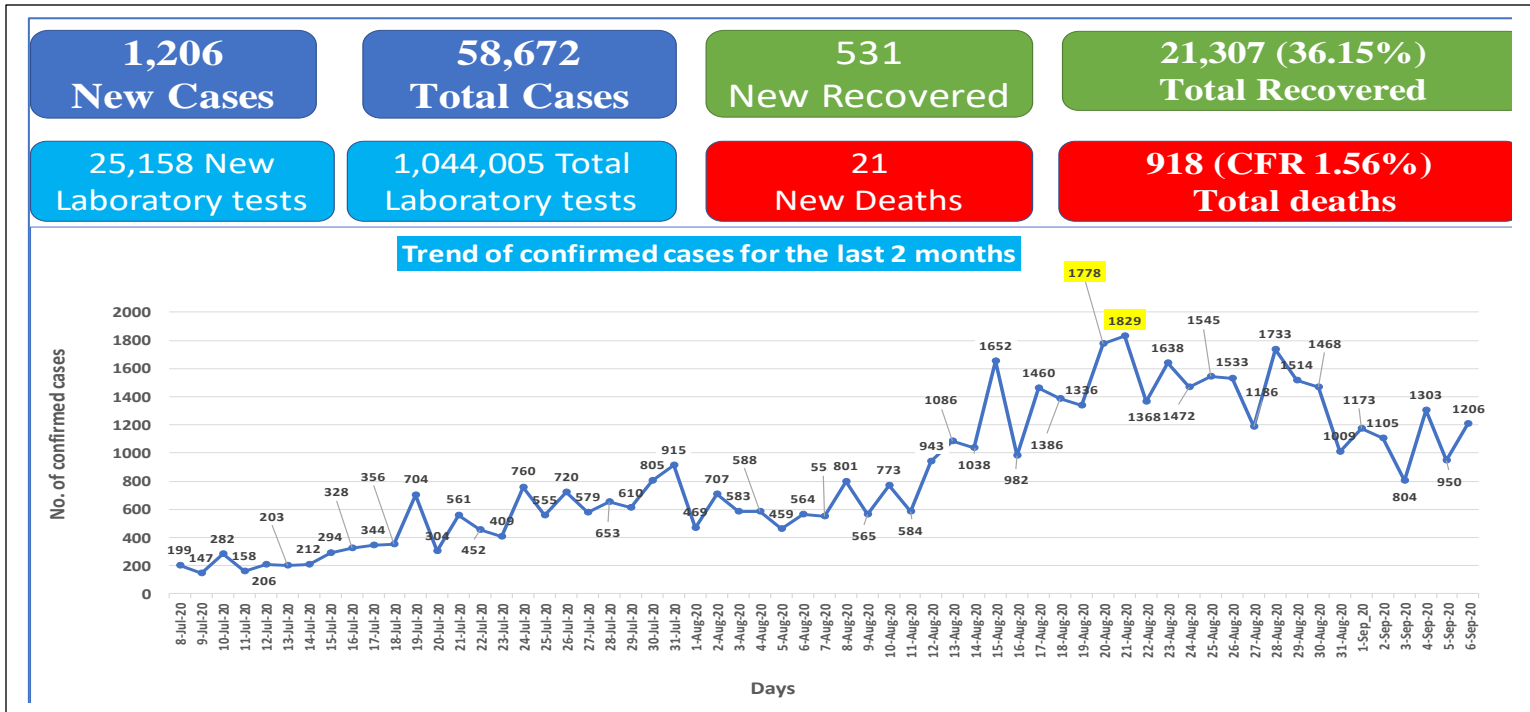


Fig. 4: Prevalence of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Ethiopia, 06-Sep 2020
