



- South Africa experiencing second wave of the outbreak








Fig. 3: Epidemiological details of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Ethiopia, 16-Dec 2020




Fig. 4: Distribution of cumulative confirmed COVID-19 cases across the regions, Ethiopia; 16-Dec-2020
