

WHAT IS THE SITUATION IN ETHIOPIA

- ◆ On 13th March-2020, Ethiopia reported the first confirmed case of COVID-19 in Addis Ababa City and as of 16-March-2020, a total of 5 confirmed cases have been reported
- ◆ Two hundred seven (207) contacts have been identified and are on close follow up.
- ◆ A comprehensive coordinated approach is being applied, and solid work being done especially in the areas of contact tracing, case investigation, case management, Infection prevention and control, laboratory and risk communication
- WHO is working closely with the government of Ethiopia in coordinating and providing critical technical

Fig 1: African Countries reporting confirmed COVID-19 cases as of March 16, 2020




30 African countries have so far reported 354 confirmed COVID-19 cases reflecting a 90% within the last 48

- ♦ Take preventive measures extremely seriously
- ♦ Avoid hand-shake and hugging at all times
- Wash hands frequently with soap and water or use an alcohol base hand rub
- ♦ Get information from reliable sources only

GLOBALY HIGHLIGHTS

- ♦ WHO declared COVID-19 a pandemic on 11-March-2020.
- ♦ WHO advises countries to invest more in testing suspected cases so that the response is based on scientific evidence
- ♦ WHO advises member states to stick to the containment strategy as the best practice so far as proven in China
- ♦ 148 countries/Regions are affected of which 26 are in Africa region including Ethiopia
- ◆ As of 15-March-2020, there were 153,517 total confirmed cases and 5,735 total deaths with a resultant increase of 15.6% and 15.7% respectively in the last 48 hours)



- ♦ 56.3% of the cases are reported by the top 10 countries listed in figure 2 above. The confirmed cases increased by 53% in the last 48 hours
- ◆ Europe has now become the epicenter of the pandemic, with more reported cases and deaths than the rest of the world combined, apart from China
- ◆ Signs and symptoms of COVID-19 are: Fever, Cough, Sore throat, Difficulty in breathing and other flu like symptoms such as running nose and sneezing
- ◆ The public is advised to report any suspected cases to the nearest health facility or call 8335 or +251929908433
