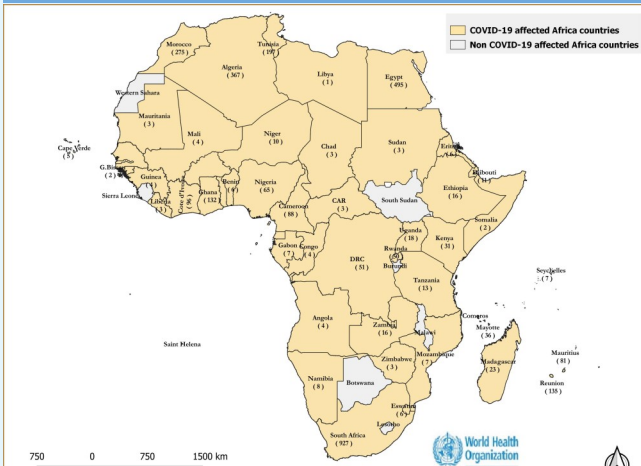

GLOBALY HIGHLIGHTS

- ◆ As of 26-March-2020, there were 462684 total confirmed cases and 20834 total deaths with a resultant increase of 11.9% and 13.0% respectively in the last 24 hours
- ◆ 176 countries/Regions are affected of which 46 are in Africa

BLACK WOMEN'S HEALTH IMPERATIVE COVID-19 PROTECTIONS

-  When you come home try not to touch anything.
-  Take off your shoes when you enter.
-  Take off outer clothing and put in a bag.
-  Leave bag, purse, keys, etc. stored at the entrance.
-  Shower, or wash all exposed areas thoroughly.
-  Clean your phone and glasses with soap and water or alcohol.
-  Clean the surfaces of what you brought from outside, before storing.
-  Remove gloves carefully, throw them away and wash your hands.
-  It is not possible to do a total disinfection. Just reduce the risk.

In Africa, only 9 countries namely **Botswana, Burundi, Comoros, Lesotho, Malawi, Sao Tome, South Sudan, Sierra Leone and Western Sahara** have not reported a single confirmed COVID-19 case.

A total of 3,433 confirmed cases and 92 deaths with a case fatality rate of 2.7%.
