



WHO is working with affected countries on strategies for gradually and safely easing restrictions, but the following factors should be considered:

- Ascertain that transmission is controlled
- Availability of sufficient public health and medical services
- Outbreak risks in special settings like long-term care facilities are minimized
- The preventive measures are in workplaces, schools and other places where it's essential for people to go
- The importation risks can be managed
- Communities are fully aware and engaged in the transition.
