WHO RESPONSE

Countries with confirmed coronavirus cases as of 12-April 2020

WHO launched three tools to help managers and planners calculate the health workers, supplies and equipment that will be needed for the increase in COVID-19 patients in different countries.

The new United Nations Supply Chain Task Force coordinated by WHO and the World Food Programme is mandated to coordinate and scale up the procurement and distribution of personal protective equipment, lab diagnostics and oxygen to the countries. This system will consist of hubs in Belgium, China, Ethiopia, Ghana, Malaysia, Panama, South Africa and the United Arab Emirates to ease distribution.







In Africa, the top 5 countries reported 8,140 confirmed cases representing 55.4% of the total reported confirmed cases.


Additionally, they have reported 567 deaths accounting for 73.1% of the total deaths in Africa
