Fig. 2: Prevalence of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Africa, 14-April-2020

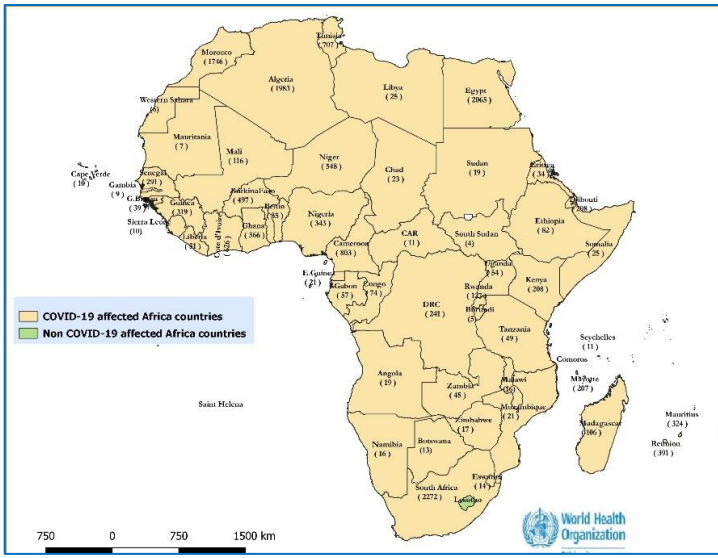
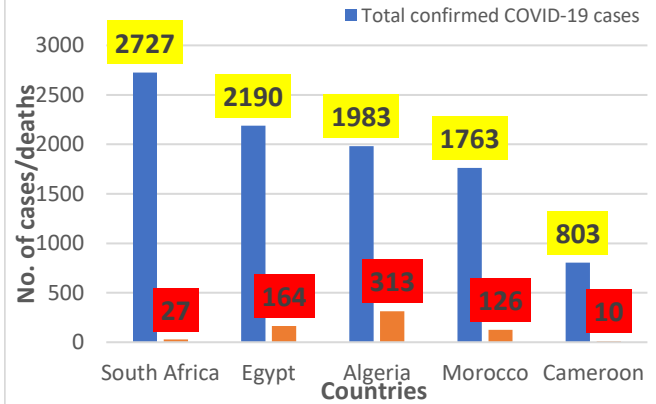


Fig. 3: Top 5 African countries reporting the highest number of confirmed COVID-19 cases



In Africa, the top 5 countries reported 9,466 confirmed cases representing 60.4% of the total reported confirmed cases. This represents a 3.7% increase in the last 24 hours. Additionally, they have reported 640 deaths accounting for 78.2% of the total deaths in Africa

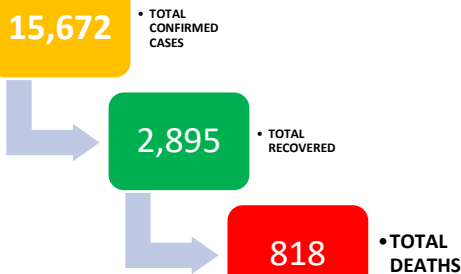
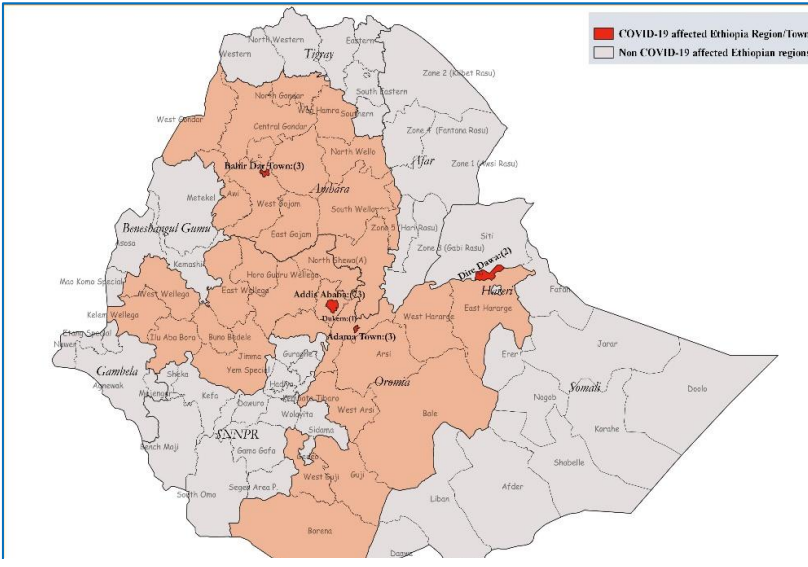


Fig. 4: Map of Ethiopia indicating COVID-19 affected regions as of 14 April 2020
