
## WHO RESPONSE

JNITED NATIONS

- More than 1.5 million have been trained in WHO's online courses on COVID-19 through OpenWHO.org, we therefore encourage everyone to enroll and undergo these relevant trainings and are free of charge
- WHO continues to work with partners all over the world to accelerate research and development where more than 90 countries have joined or have expressed interest in joining the Solidarity Trial, and more than 900 patients have now been enrolled, to evaluate the safety and efficacy of four drugs and drug combinations.
- Additionally, WHO has convened groups of clinicians to look at the impact of corticosteroids and other anti-inflammatory drugs on treatment outcomes.


