Fig. 1: Prevalence of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Africa, 17-April-2020

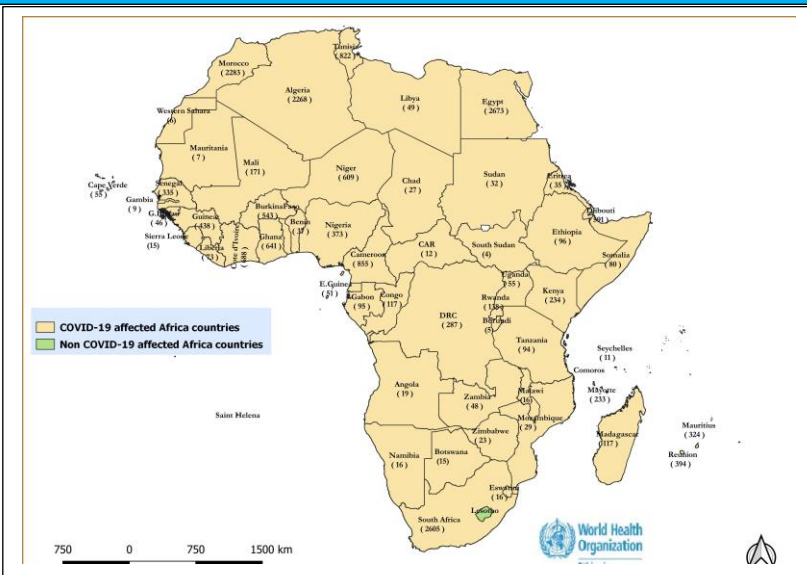
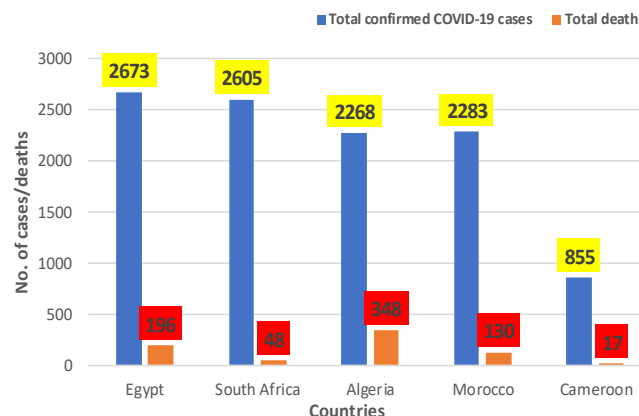


Fig 2: Top 5 African countries reporting the highest number of confirmed COVID-19 cases



- In Africa, the top 5 countries reported 10,684 confirmed cases and 739 deaths representing 56.6% of the total reported confirmed cases and 76.8% deaths respectively.
- Community transmission in these countries is evident
- However, the rate of increase of cases in Kenya, Tanzania and Ethiopia is worrying.

Fig. 3: Map of Ethiopia indicating COVID-19 affected regions as of 17 April 2020

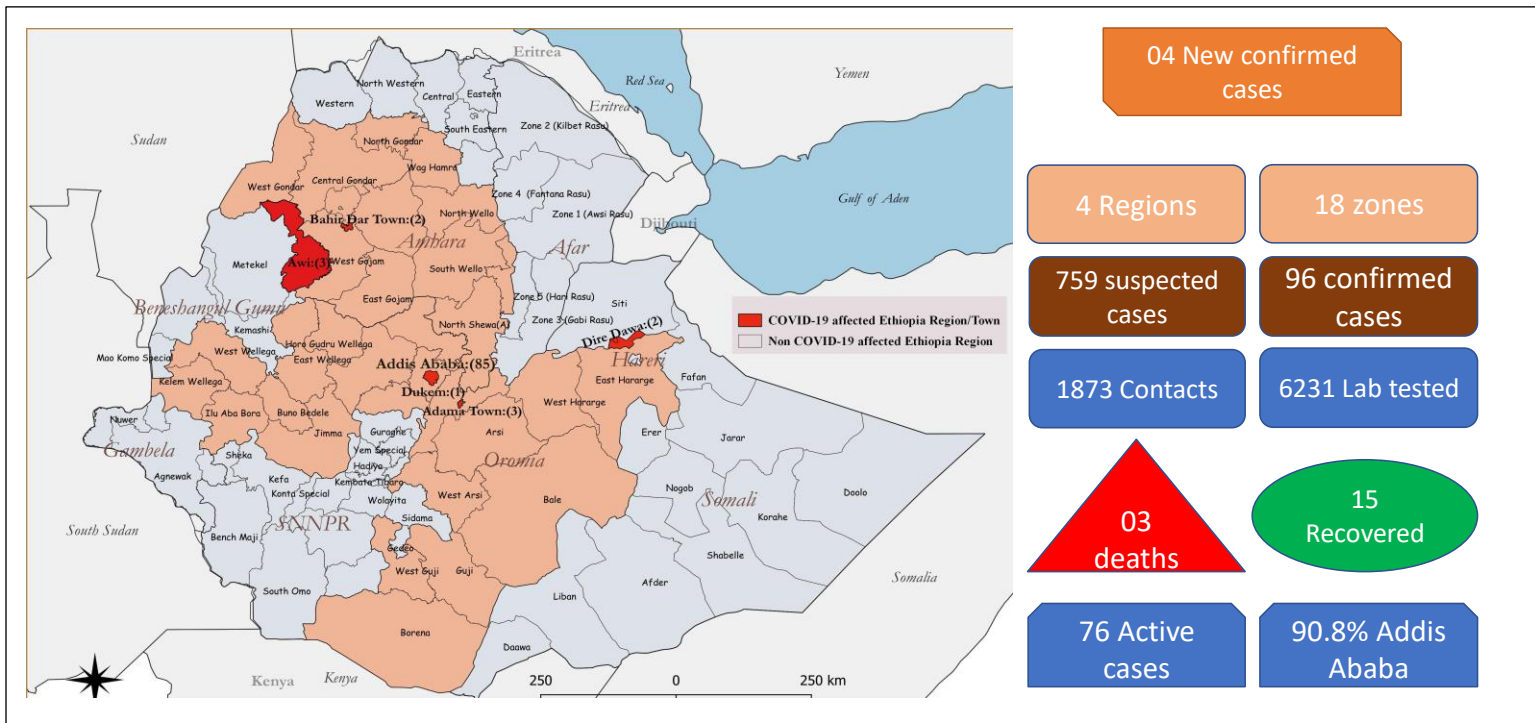


Fig. 4: Distribution of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Addis Ababa, 17-April 2020
