Fig. 1: Prevalence of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Africa, 23-April-2020

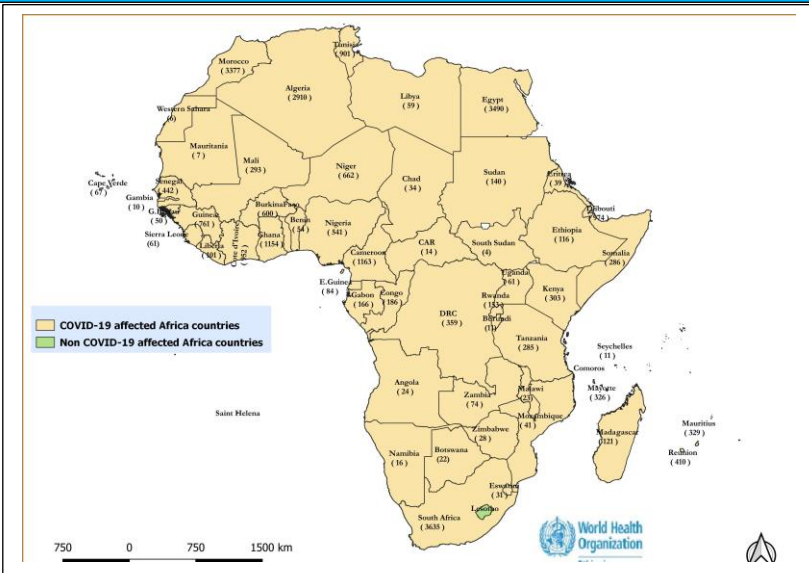
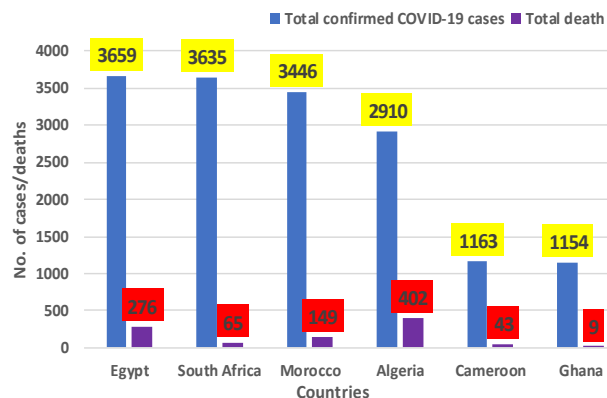


Fig 2: Top 6 African countries reporting the highest number of confirmed COVID-19 cases

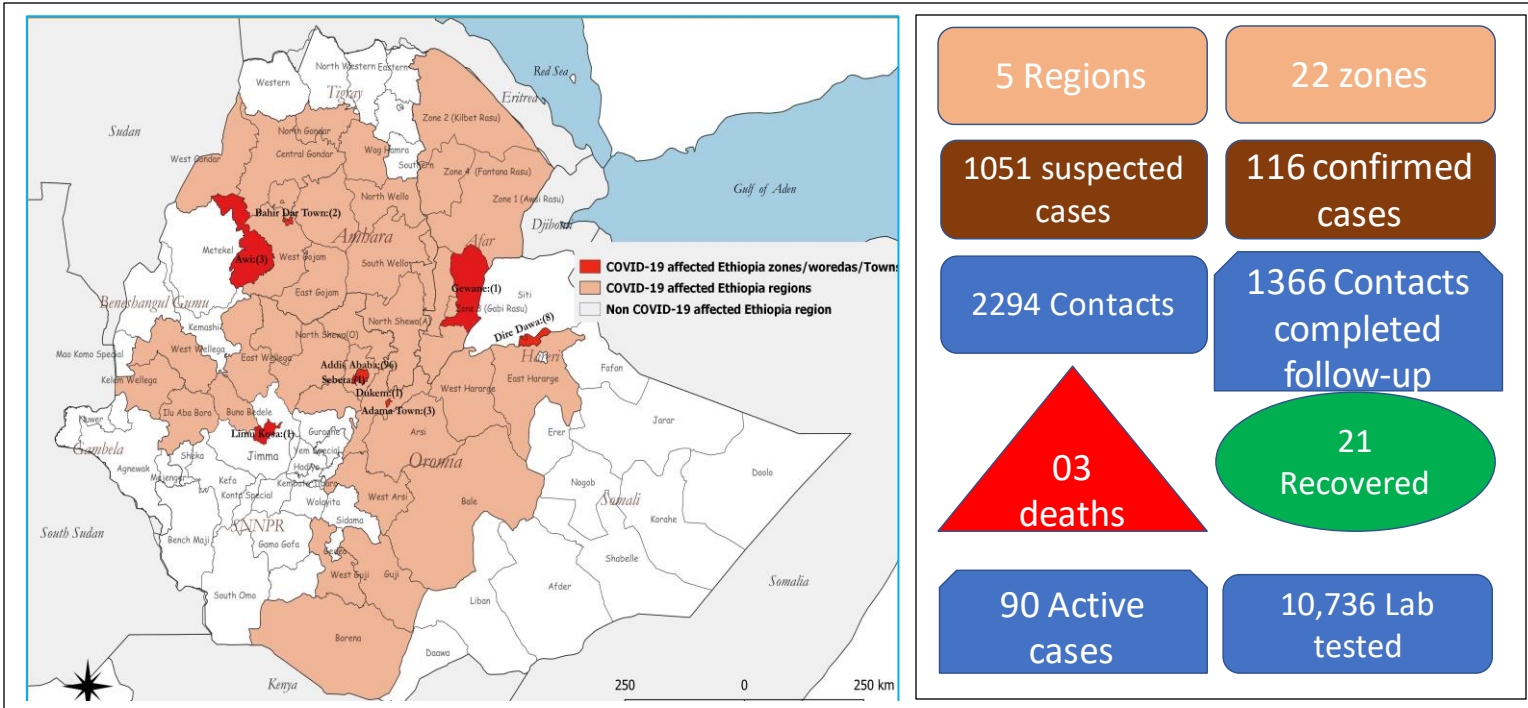
