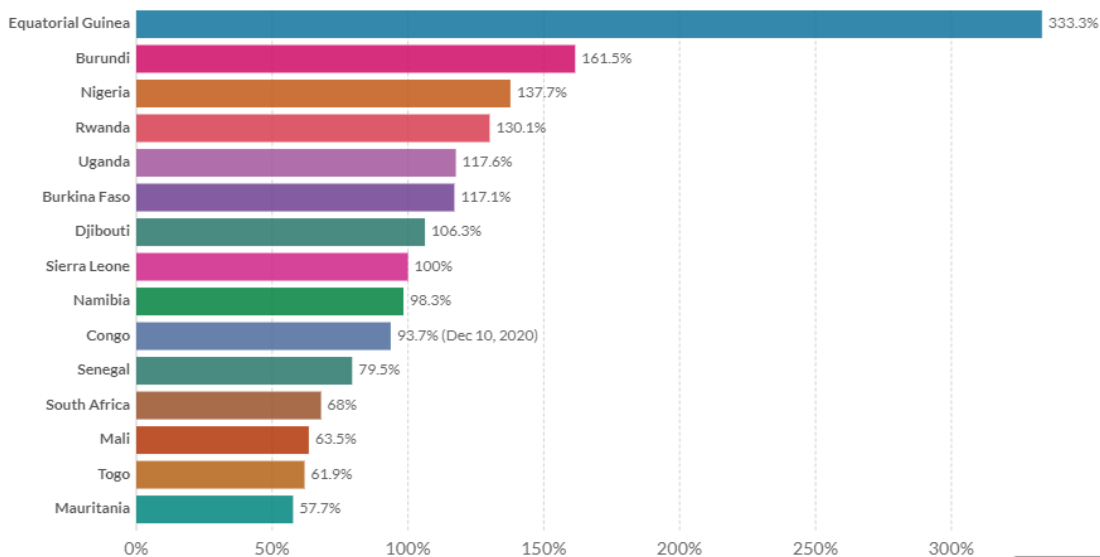

The graph indicates the percentage change in number of confirmed cases over the last seven days relative to the number in the previous seven days. Countries like Ethiopia, Morocco and Tunisia recorded significant number of cases but when compared the previous week, the percentage change is less than zero. Therefore, more effort is needed to address the drivers in the countries with notable community transmission.

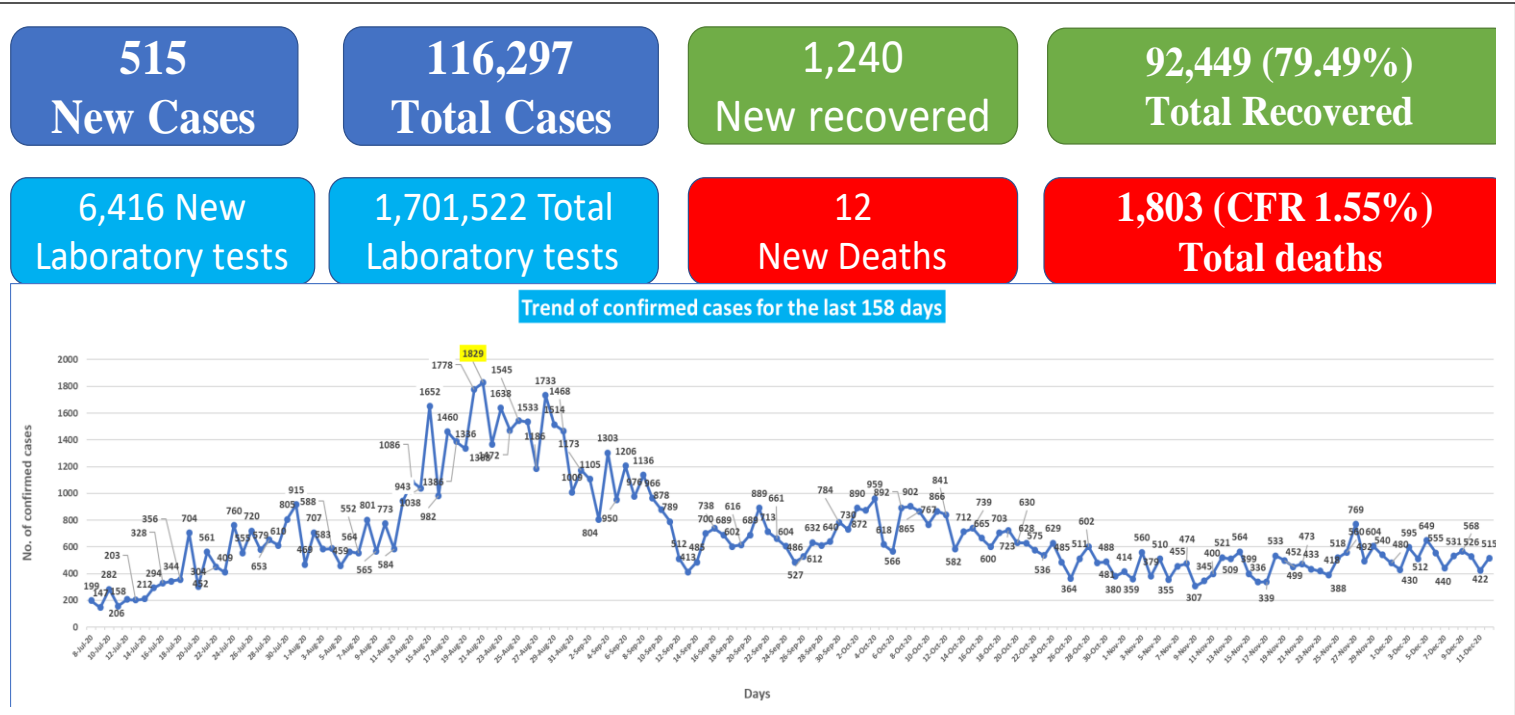


Fig. 4: Distribution of cumulative confirmed COVID-19 cases across the regions, Ethiopia; 12-Dec-2020
